Naturalist Journeys 2024 Costa Rica: Nature & Birding featured lots of wonderful birds as expected, with 27 species of hummingbirds, 29 species of flycatchers, 18 species of warblers and 20 species of tanagers and their allies. Even though birds were the focus of the tour, there were always interesting mammals or reptiles or amphibians to see at each stop. TINAMOUS: Tinamidae (1)

Great Tinamou *Tinamus major*— (1/1) A single bird was seen from one of the trails at La Selva Biological Station and was heard at Carara National Park on the PCE.

DUCKS, GEESE AND SWANS: Anatidae (4)

Black-bellied Whistling-Duck Dendrocygna autumnalis— (1) A small flock was seen in flight at Angostura Lagoon.

Muscovy Duck Cairina moschata— (1) Three were seen at the Ensenada Lodge property.

Blue-winged Teal *Spatula discors*— (1/2) Small numbers seen at Angostura Lagoon with more seen at the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Lesser Scaup Aythya affinis— (1) Small numbers seen at Angostura Lagoon.

GUANS AND CURASSOWS: Cracidae (3)

Gray-headed Chachalaca *Ortalis cinereiceps*— (4) Primarily seen at fruit feeding stations at Pierella Garden, La Quinta Lodge and Rancho Naturalista. Also seen at Guayabo National Monument.

Crested Guan *Penelope purpurescens*—(5) Seen at Pierella Garden, La Selva Biological Station, Rancho Naturalista and Guayabo National Monument.

Black Guan (RE) Chamaepetes unicolor— (1) HO, on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge.

PIGEONS AND DOVES: Columbidae (9)

Rock Pigeon (I) Columba livia— (1) Many seen while driving through Cartago.

Red-billed Pigeon *Patagioenas flavirostris*— (5) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Pierella Garden and Rancho Naturalista.

Ruddy Pigeon Patagioenas subvinacea— (1) HO, on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge.

Short-billed Pigeon *Patagioenas nigrirostris*— (2/1) HO, at La Selva Biological Station, Guayabo National Monument and Carara National Park on the PCE.

Inca Dove *Columbina inca*— (1) Seen at the Ensenada Lodge.

Common Ground Dove *Columbina passerina*— (1) Seen at the Ensenada Lodge.

Ruddy Ground-Dove *Columbina talpacoti*— (2) Seen at Angostura Lagoon.

White-tipped Dove Leptotila verreauxi— (2/2) Seen at La Selva Biological Station, La Quinta Lodge, Rancho Naturalista, on the Tarcoles River boat tour and at Carara National Park on the PCE.

White-winged Dove Zenaida asiatica— (5/3) Widespread, seen at multiple locations.

CUCKOOS AND ALLIES: Cuculidae (2)

Groove-billed Ani *Crotophaga sulcirostris*— (1/2) Seen at Angostura Lagoon and at Ensenada Lodge and surrounding property on the PCE.

Squirrel Cuckoo Piaya cayana— (2) Seen at Virgen del Socorro and La Selva Biological Station.

NIGHTJARS: Caprimulgidae (2)

Lesser Nighthawk *Chordeiles acutipennis*— (1) Four were seen on the Ensenada Lodge property.

Common Pauraque *Nyctidromus albicollis*— (1) One bird seen on the ground close up at Pierella Garden.

SWIFTS: Apodidae (3)

Chestnut-collared Swift *Streptoprocne rutila*— (1) Six were seen flying with White-collared Swifts at Ensenada Lodge.

White-collared Swift Streptoprocne zonaris— (1) Seen at Ensenada Lodge.

Gray-rumped Swift Chaetura cinereiventris— (1) Seen at La Selva Biological Station.

HUMMINGBIRDS: Trochilidae (27)

White-necked Jacobin Florisuga mellivora— (4) Seen at the feeders at Pierella Garden and Rancho Naturalista.

Band-tailed Barbthroat Threnetes ruckeri— (1) One seen at the bathing pools at Rancho Naturalista.

Green Hermit Phaethornis guy— (1) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Stripe-throated Hermit Phaethornis striigularis— (2) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Lesser Violetear *Colibri cyanotus*— (2) Seen at Paraiso Quetzales, Trogon Lodge and Miriam's Restaurant.

Green-breasted Mango *Anthracothorax prevostii*— (2) Seen at Rancho Naturalista and seen perched on a wire while looking at some oropendola nests shortly after leaving Rancho Naturalista.

Green Thorntail Discosura conversii— (1) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Black-crested Coquette *Lophornis helenae*— (1) An adult male was seen at Rancho Naturalista feeding in a verbena hedge.

Green-crowned Brilliant *Heliodoxa jacula*— (1) Seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona.

Talamanca Hummingbird (RE) *Eugenes spectabillis*— (3) Seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona, Paraiso Quetzales, Trogon Lodge and Miriam's Restaurant.

Fiery-throated Hummingbird (RE) Panterpe insignis— (2) Seen at Paraiso Quetzales and Miriam's Restaurant.

White-throated Mountain-gem (RE) Lampornis castaneoventris— (2) Seen at Paraiso Quetzales, Trogon Lodge and Miriam's Restaurant.

Ruby-throated Hummingbird *Archilochus colubris*— (2) Seen at Ensenada Lodge.

Volcano Hummingbird (RE) *Selasphorus flammula*— (2) Seen at Paraiso Quetzales, Trogon Lodge and Miriam's Restaurant.

Canivet's Emerald Cynanthus canivetii— (1) Seen at Ensenada Lodge.

Garden Emerald *Chlorostilbon assimilis*— (1) Seen in the same verbena hedge at Rancho Naturalista as the Blackcrested Coquette and Snowcap.

Violet-headed Hummingbird *Klais guimeti*— (1) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Violet Sabrewing *Campylopterus hemileucurus*— (1) Seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona.

Crowned Woodnymph Thalurania colombica— (2) Seen at the feeders and bathing pools at Rancho Naturalista.

Snowcap (RE) *Microchera albocoronata*— (1) A juvenile male and female were seen feeding in a verbena hedge at Rancho Naturalista.

Coppery-headed Emerald (E) Microchera cupreiceps— (1) Seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona.

Black-bellied Hummingbird (RE) Eupherusa nigriventris— (1) A male was seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona.

Scaly-breasted Hummingbird *Phaeochroa cuvierii*— (2) One was heard at Pierella Garden and one was seen at La Quinta Lodge.

Blue-vented Hummingbird *Saucerottia hoffmanni*— (3) Seen at Ensenada Lodge and along the Guacimo Road. **Cinnamon Hummingbird** *Amazilia rutila*— (2) Seen on the Ensenada Lodge property and along the Guacimo Road.

Rufous-tailed Hummingbird *Amazilia tzacatl*— (5) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, La Selva Biological Station, La Quinta Lodge and Rancho Naturalista.

Blue-throated Goldentail *Chlorestes eliciae*— (1) HO, at Carara National Park.

RAILS, COOTS AND ALLIES: Rallidae (4)

Russet-naped Wood-Rail *Aramides albiventris*— (2) One seen at Pierella Garden and a pair on the Sarapiqui River boat tour.

Common Gallinule *Gallinula galeata*— (1) Seen at Angostura Lagoon.

Purple Gallinule *Porphyrio martinica*—(1) Seen at Angostura Lagoon.

White-throated Crake Laterallus albigularis— (2) HO, on the Sarapiqui River boat tour and at Angostura Lagoon.

LIMPKIN: Aramidae (1)

Limpkin Aramus guarauna— (1) One seen at Angostura Lagoon.

STILTS AND AVOCETS: Recurvirostridae (1)

Black-necked Stilt *Himantopus mexicanus*— (3) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour and on the Ensenada Lodge property.

PLOVERS AND LAPWINGS: Charadriidae (4)

Black-bellied Plover *Pluvialis squatarola*— (1) Four were seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

Southern Lapwing *Vanellus chilensis*— (3) Seen enroute in the Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui area, on the Sarapiqui River boat tour and at Angostura Lagoon.

Wilson's Plover Charadrius wilsonia— (1) One seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

Semipalmated Plover *Charadrius semipalmatus*— (1) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour and the Ensenada Lodge property.

JACANAS: Jacanidae (1)

Northern Jacana *Jacana spinosa*— (2/1) Seen at a small wetland along the road in the Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui area, Angostura Lagoon and the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

SANDPIPERS AND ALLIES: Scolopacidae (11)

Whimbrel *Numenius phaeopus*— (3) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour, the Ensenada Lodge property and the Ensenada Lodge boat tour.

Long-billed Curlew Numenius americanus— (1) One seen on the Ensenada Lodge boat tour.

Marbled Godwit Limosa fedoa— (1) Ten seen on the Ensenada Lodge boat tour.

Ruddy Turnstone Arenaria interpres— (1) Five seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

Stilt Sandpiper *Calidris himantopus*— (1) Fourteen seen on the Ensenada Lodge property.

Least Sandpiper *Calidris minutilla*— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour and on the Ensenada Lodge property. **Short-billed Dowitcher** *Limnodromus griseus*— (1) One seen on the Ensenada Lodge boat tour.

Wilson's Snipe Gallinago delicata— (1) One seen at Angostura Lagoon.

Spotted Sandpiper *Actitis macularius*— (2/2) Seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour, Angostura Lagoon, on the Tarcoles River and the Ensenada Lodge boat tours on the PCE.

Greater Yellowlegs Tringa melanoleuca— (1) Two seen on the Ensenada Lodge property.

Willet *Tringa semipalmata*— (3) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour, the Ensenada Lodge property and on the Ensenada Lodge boat tour.

GULLS, TERNS AND SKIMMERS: Ciconiidae (4)

Laughing Gull *Leucophaeus atricilla*— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and the Ensenada Lodge boat tours.

Black Skimmer *Rynchops niger*— (1) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

Royal Tern Thalasseus maximus— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and the Ensenada Lodge boat tours.

Sandwich Tern Thalasseus sandvicensis— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and the Ensenada Lodge boat tours.

SUNBITTERN: Eurypygidae (1)

Sunbittern Eurypyga helias— (1) One seen sitting on a nest along a stream in Platanillo.

STORKS: Ciconiidae (1)

Wood Stork *Mycteria americana*— (2/4) One seen high above La Selva Biological Station riding a thermal, another at Angostura Lagoon, two on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada boat tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

FRIGATEBIRDS: Fregatidae (1)

Magnificent Frigatebird *Fregata magnificens*— (2) Several seen on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property.

ANHINGAS: Anhingidae (1)

Anhinga Anhinga anhinga— (2/1) Seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour, at Angostura Lagoon and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

CORMORANTS: Phalacrocoracidae (1)

Neotropic Cormorant *Nannopterum brasilianum*— (1/2) Several seen at Angostura Lagoon, on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada boat tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

PELICANS: Pelecanidae (1)

Brown Pelican Pelecanus occidentalis— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat tours.

HERONS AND EGRETS: Ardeidae (11)

Bare-throated Tiger-Heron *Tigrisoma mexicanum*— (2/1) Seen at Pierella Garden, La Quinta Lodge and on the Tarcoles River boat tour on the PCE.

Great Blue Heron *Ardea herodias*— (3/2) Seen at a small wetland along the road in the Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui area, Angostura Lagoon and on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours on the PCE.

Great Egret *Ardea alba*— (3/3) Seen at a small wetland along the road in the Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui area, Angostura Lagoon, on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Snowy Egret *Egretta thula*— (1/3) Seen at Angostura Lagoon, on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Little Blue Heron *Egretta caerulea*— (2/3) Seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour, Angostura Lagoon, on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Tricolored Heron *Egretta tricolor*— (2/2) Seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour, Angostura Lagoon and on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours on the PCE.

Western Cattle Egret Bubulcus ibis— (5/2) Seen at multiple locations

Green Heron *Butorides virescens*— (3/1) Seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour, La Quinta Lodge, Angostura Lagoon and Ensenada Lodge boat river tour on the PCE.

Black-crowned Night-Heron *Nycticorax nycticorax*— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours on the PCE.

Yellow-crowned Night-Heron *Nyctanassa violacea*— (1/3) Seen at Angostura Lagoon, on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Boat-billed Heron *Cochlearius cochlearius*— (1) One seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

IBIS AND SPOONBILLS: Threskiornithidae (3)

White Ibis Eudocimus albus—(3) Several seen on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat tours and on the Ensenada Lodge property.

Green Ibis *Mesembrinibis cayennensis*—(2) Seen and heard at the La Quinta Lodge and seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour.

Roseate Spoonbill Platalea ajaja— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour and on the Ensenada Lodge property.

NEW WORLD VULTURES: Cathartidae (3)

King Vulture *Sarcoramphus papa*— (1) A single bird was seen gliding high above the forest at La Selva Biological Station.

Black Vulture Coragyps atratus— (6/3) Numerous, seen almost daily.

Turkey Vulture Cathartes aura— (7/3) Numerous, seen almost daily.

OSPREY: Pandionidae (1)

Osprey Pandion haliaetus— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat river tours on the PCE.

HAWKS, KITES AND EAGLES: Accipitridae (7)

Snail Kite *Rostrhamus sociabilis*— (1) A few were seen at Angostura Lagoon.

Bicolored Hawk *Accipiter bicolor*— (1) One seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Common Black Hawk Buteogallus anthracinus— (1) Two Seen on the Tarcoles River boat river tour on the PCE.

Roadside Hawk Rupornis magnirostris— (1) One seen and heard at Guayabo National Monument.

Broad-winged Hawk Buteo platypterus— (1) One seen on the way to Cinchona on the 12th.

Short-tailed Hawk *Buteo brachyurus*— (1/1) One seen in flight at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona and one on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Red-tailed Hawk Buteo jamaicensis— (2) One seen on the way to Cinchona on the 12th.

OWLS: Strigidae (4)

Pacific Screech-Owl Megascops cooperi— (1) One seen at the Ensenada Lodge on the PCE.

Costa Rican Pygmy-Owl (RE) *Glaucidium costaricanum*— (1) One seen and two others heard on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge.

Ferruginous Pygmy-Owl *Glaucidium brasilianum*— (1/4) One seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, one on the Tarcoles River boat tour, two at the Ensenada Lodge and another on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Mottled Owl Strix virgata— (2) Two seen at Hotel Bougainvillea.

TROGONS: Trogonidae (5)

Resplendent Quetzal *Pharomachrus mocinno*— (2) Two males and three females seen at Paraiso Quetzales, a male and female seen at Trogon Lodge and two others heard on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge. **Slaty-tailed Trogon** *Trogon massena*— (1) Two males and a female seen at La Selva Biological Station.

Black-headed Trogon *Trogon melanocephalus*— (3) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour and on the Ensenada Lodge property.

Gartered Trogon *Trogon caligatus*— (2) Heard at Pierella Garden and two seen at La Selva Biological Station.

Northern Black-throated Trogon *Trogon rufus*— (2) Heard on the 13th and two seen on the 14th at La Quinta Lodge.

MOTMOTS: Momotidae (4)

Lesson's Motmot *Momotus lessonii*— (4/1) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Rancho Naturalista and Carara National Park on the PCE.

Rufous Motmot *Baryphthengus martii*— (2) Seen and heard at La Selva Biological Station and heard at Rancho Naturalista.

Broad-billed Motmot *Electron platyrhynchum*— (2) Seen at La Quinta Lodge and La Selva Biological Station on the 13th and heard at La Quinta on the morning of the 14th.

Turquoise-browed Motmot Eumomota superciliosa— (1) One seen on the Ensenada Lodge property.

KINGFISHERS: Alcedinidae (5)

Ringed Kingfisher Megaceryle torquata— (1/1) One briefly seen but heard as well at La Quinta Lodge and one seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour on the PCE.

Belted Kingfisher Megaceryle alcyon— (2) Seen on the Tarcoles River and Ensenada Lodge boat tours.

Amazon Kingfisher Chloroceryle amazona— (1/1) One seen from the suspension bridge at La Selva Biological Station, one on the Sarapiqui River boat tour and two on the Tarcoles River boat tour on the PCE.

American Pygmy Kingfisher Chloroceryle aenea— (1) One seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

Green Kingfisher Chloroceryle americana — (1/1) Two seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour and one on the Tarcoles River boat tour on the PCE.

PUFFBIRDS: Bucconidae (2)

White-necked Puffbird Notharchus hyperrhynchus— (1) Two seen at Carara National Park. White-whiskered Puffbird Malacoptila panamensis— (1) One seen at Ensenada Lodge.

JACAMARS: Galbulidae (1)

Rufous-tailed Jacamar *Galbula ruficauda*— (1) One seen at Pierella Garden.

NEW WORLD BARBETS: Capitonidae (1)

Red-headed Barbet *Eubucco bourcierii*— (1) One seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona.

TOUCANS: Ramphastidae (4)

Northern Emerald-Toucanet Aulacorhynchus prasinus—(1) One seen at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona.

Collared Aracari *Pteroglossus torquatus*—(4) Seen at Pierella Garden, La Selva Biological Station, La Quinta Lodge and Rancho Naturalista.

Yellow-throated Toucan *Ramphastos ambiguus*— (4) Seen at Pierella Garden, La Quinta Lodge, La Selva Biological Station, on the Sarapiqui River boat tour and heard at Guayabo National Monument.

Keel-billed Toucan *Ramphastos sulfuratus*— (3) Heard and then seen at Rancho Naturalista and seen again at Guayabo National Monument.

WOODPECKERS: Picidae (11)

Yellow-bellied Sapsucker Sphyrapicus varius— (1) One seen on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge.

Acorn Woodpecker *Melanerpes formicivorus*— (1) A family group seen on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge and a single bird at Miriam's Restaurant.

Black-cheeked Woodpecker *Melanerpes pucherani*— (4) Seen at Pierella Garden, La Quinta Lodge, La Selva Biological Station, Rancho Naturalista and Angostura Lagoon.

Hoffmann's Woodpecker (RE) *Melanerpes hoffmannii*— (1/2) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, on the Tarcoles River boat tour, Carara National Park and on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Hairy Woodpecker Dryobates villosus— (1) One bird seen at Miriam's Restaurant.

Pale-billed Woodpecker Campephilus guatemalensis— (1) One seen at Ensenada Lodge.

Lineated Woodpecker *Dryocopus lineatus*— (2/2) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Angostura Lagoon and at Ensenada Lodge on the PCE.

Cinnamon Woodpecker *Celeus loricatus*— (1) HO, on the Sarapiqui River boat tour.

Chestnut-colored Woodpecker Celeus castaneus— (2) Seen at Pierella Garden and La Selva Biological Station.

Rufous-winged Woodpecker (RE) *Piculus simplex*— (1) Seen at La Selva Biological Station.

Golden-olive Woodpecker Colaptes rubiginosus— (2) HO, at Colibri Cafe/Cinchona and Rancho Naturalista.

FALCONS AND CARACARAS: Falconidae (6)

Laughing Falcon *Herpetotheres cachinnans*— (1/1) Heard at Rancho Naturalista and seen at Ensenada Lodge on the PCE.

Collared Forest-Falcon *Micrastur semitorquatus*— (1) One seen at Carara National Park.

Barred Forest-Falcon *Micrastur ruficollis*— (1) HO, at Angostura Lagoon.

Crested Caracara Caracara plancus— (4) Twe seen together enroute near Cinchona.

Yellow-headed Caracara Daptrius chimachima— (2) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea and Angostura Lagoon.

Peregrine Falcon Falco peregrinus— (1) One seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

PARROTS: Psittacidae (11)

Barred Parakeet Bolborhynchus lineola— (2) Seen at Trogon Lodge and Miriam's Restaurant.

Orange-chinned Parakeet *Brotogeris jugularis*— (3/2) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Pierella Garden, La Selva Biological Station, heard at Angostura Lagoon and seen on the Ensenada Lodge property on the PCE.

Brown-hooded Parrot *Pyrilia haematotis*— (1) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

White-crowned Parrot Pionus senilis— (3) Seen at La Selva Biological Station, Rancho Naturalista and Angostura Lagoon.

Red-lored Parrot Amazona autumnalis— (2) Seen at Pierella Garden and La Quinta Lodge.

Yellow-naped Parrot *Amazona auropalliata*— (3) Seen on the Tarcoles River boat tour and at Ensenada Lodge.

White-fronted Parrot Amazona albifrons— (2) Seen on the Ensenada Lodge property.

Sulphur-winged Parakeet (RE) *Pyrrhura hoffmanni*— (1) HO, on the trail above the Savegre Mountain Lodge.

Orange-fronted Parakeet Eupsittula canicularis— (2) Seen at the Ensenada Lodge.

Scarlet Macaw *Ara macao*— (2/2) Seen near Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui, on the Tarcoles River boat tour and Carara National Park on the PCE.

Crimson-fronted Parakeet (RE) Psittacara finschi— (3) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea and Rancho Naturalista.
