The following is a list of additional mammal and reptile species we observed during the trip.

MAMMALS (5)

Pronghorn Antilocapra americana—Impressive 40+ observed in late afternoon just east of Sonoita.
Coues White-tailed Deer Odocoileus virginianus couesi—Regular in Madera, Carr and Ramsey Canyons.
Collared Peccary Pecari tajacu—Observed at Tubac Golf Resort and in Sierra Vista.
Coyote Canis latrans—Noted at Whitewater Draw Wildlife Area and near Hereford.
Desert Cottontail Sylvilagus audubonii–Only observed by Buck.
Black-tailed Jackrabbit Lepus californicus—Viewed by Buck along road in evening after the farewell dinner.
Rock Squirrel Otospermophilus variegatus—Spotted at Madera Canyon feeders and road to Santa Cruz R.
Round-tailed Ground Squirrel Xerospermophilus tereticaudus—Several at the San Xavier de Bac Mission.

Arizona Gray Squirrel Sciurus arizonensis—They were everywhere at the Paton's Center for Hummingbirds.

REPTILES (3)

Pond Slider *Trachemys scripta*—(Non-native)--Individual sunbathing at Patagonia Lake State Park.
