

Trinidad & Tobago Species List | March 13 – 22, 2025 with Naturalist Journeys

Our tour began in Trinidad, where our accommodations included Hacienda Jacana, the Mt. Plaisier Hotel and the Asa Wright Nature Center. In addition to the grounds of each of these locations, our birding activities included time in the Nariva Swamp, Bajnath's Hummingbird Estate, Grande Riviere, Blanchisseuse Road and the Caroni Swamp. For the final segment of the tour, we relocated to Tobago, where the Cuffie River Nature Retreat served as our very birdy base. Other birding locations we explored in Tobago included the Bon Accord water treatment ponds, Adventure Farm, the Main Ridge Forest Preserve and Little Tobago Island.

As a group, we recorded a total of 191 bird species - one was heard only, two were endemic and one was introduced.
