#### BIRDS (133):

#### **DUCKS, GEESE AND SWANS: Anatidae (13)**

**Graylag Goose** Anser anser — (3) Around 30 at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3.

**Mute Swan** Cygnus olor — (8) Common and widespread in both countries.

**Ruddy Shelduck** Tadorna ferruginea — (1) One seen at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria on day 5.

**Common Shelduck** *Tadorna tadorna* — (2) Seen on day 3 at Jurilovca in Romania and a dozen on day 8 from the Lake Atanasovsko Bird Hide in Bulgaria.

**Garganey** Spatula querquedula — (1) Four in eclipse plumage seen at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria on day 5.

**Northern Shoveler** *Spatula clypeata* — (4) Several groups of 100+ seen on wetlands in both countries. Most in eclipse plumage.

**Gadwall** Mareca strepera — (3) About 20 seen at Lake Durankulak in Bulgaria on day 6.

Eurasian Wigeon Mareca penelope — (1) Three at the Poda Reserve in Bulgaria on day 8.

**Mallard** Anas platyrhynchos — (8) Numerous sightings on most days in both countries.

**Northern Pintail** Anas acuta — (1) One at the Poda Reserve and five from the Lake Atanasovsko Bird Hide in Bulgaria on day 8.

**Green-winged (Eurasian) Teal** Anas crecca — (7) Large migrating flocks of 100s each in both countries.

Common Pochard Aythya ferina — (1) About 100 on Lake Mandra in Bulgaria on day 8.

Ferruginous Duck Aythya nyroca — (1) Two seen in flight at Lake Mandra in Bulgaria on day 8.

#### PHEASANTS, PARTRIDGES AND ALLIES: Phasianidae (2)

**Ring-necked Pheasant** *Phasianus colchicus* — (5) Single birds heard and seen in both countries, mostly adult males.

**Gray Partridge** *Perdix perdix* — (1) A group of four seen briefly by the roadside near Shabla in Bulgaria on day 5.

#### FLAMINGOS: Phoenicopteridae (1)

**Greater Flamingo** *Phoenicopterus roseus* — (1) Feeding flocks of up to 100+ on Lake Mandra and 1000+ from the Atanasovsko Bird Hide in Bulgaria on day 8.

#### **GREBES: Podicipedidae (3)**

**Little Grebe** *Tachybaptus ruficollis* — (4) Scattered sightings in both countries.

**Great Crested Grebe** *Podiceps cristatus* — (2) Around ten seen on Lake Mandra in Bulgaria.

**Eared Grebe** *Podiceps nigricollis* — (5) Scattered sightings in both countries.

#### **PIGEONS AND DOVES: Columbidae (4)**

**Rock (Feral) Pigeon** *Columba livia* — (10) Widespread. Feral "domestica" birds seen, but two possible "wild" birds were at Cheia in Romania on day 4.

**Common Wood-Pigeon** *Columba palumbus* — (6) Scattered sightings in Bulgaria.

European Turtle-Dove Streptopelia turtur — (1) Three seen near Durankulak in Bulgaria on day 6.

**Eurasian Collared-Dove** *Streptopelia decaocto* — (10) Abundant in both countries; seen both in settlements and in flocks in cereal fields.

#### **CUCKOOS:** Cuculidae (1)

**Common Cuckoo** Cuculus canorus — (2) Two seen in flight, on days 4 and 6.

#### SWIFTS: Apodidae (1)

Alpine Swift  $Tachymarptis\ melba-$  (4) Groups of up to 30 birds each seen in Bulgaria including some flying low down in Burgas city on the last day.

#### RAILS, COOTS AND ALLIES: Rallidae (3)

**Water Rail** Rallus aquaticus — (2) Heard on day 8 and one seen on day 9 at the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, in Bulgaria.

**Eurasian Moorhen** *Gallinula chloropus* — (3) Seen on day 3 at Jurilovca in Romania and on days 8 and 9 at the Izvorska River Mouth in Bulgaria.

**Eurasian Coot** Fulica atra - (5) Fairly common on wetlands in both countries.

### **THICK-KNEES: Burhinidae (1)**

Eurasian Thick-knee Burhinus oedicnemus — (1) Six on steppe near Balgarevo in Bulgaria on day 4.

#### STILTS AND AVOCETS: Recurvirostridae (1)

**Pied Avocet** Recurvirostra avosetta — (1) Two at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3.

#### PLOVERS AND LAPWINGS: Charadriidae (4)

**Black-bellied Plover** *Pluvialis squatarola* — (3) Three singles seen in Bulgaria, at Lake Shabla-Tuzla on day 6 and on days 7 and 8 at the Pomorie saltworks.

Northern Lapwing Vanellus vanellus — (1) Ten seen in flight near Sarichioi in Romania on day 3.

**Common Ringed Plover** Charadrius hiaticula — (1) Two on day 6 at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria.

**Little Ringed Plover** *Charadrius dubius* — (3) Several seen in Bulgaria, at Lake Shabla-Tuzla on day 5 and at Pomorie saltworks on days 7 and 8.

#### SANDPIPERS AND ALLIES: Scolopacidae (12)

**Eurasian Curlew** *Numenius arquata* — (3) One at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3 and 6 at Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria on days 7 and 8.

**Black-tailed Godwit**  $Limosa\ limosa - (1)$  Six at Vadu in Romania on day 2.

**Ruff** Calidris pugnax — (2) Single birds in non-breeding plumage seen at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria on days 5 and 6.

**Temminck's Stint** Calidris temminckii — (1) One seen at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria on day 5.

**Dunlin** Calidris alpina — (4) Scattered sightings with around 50 at the Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria on day 7.

Little Stint Calidris minuta — (1) Three seen at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria on day 6.

**Common Snipe** Gallinago gallinago — (5) Dozens seen on wetlands in both countries.

**Common Sandpiper** *Actitis hypoleucos* — (1) Two at the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, in Bulgaria on day 9.

Green Sandpiper Tringa ochropus — (1) One seen at Durankulak in Bulgaria on day 6.

**Common Greenshank** *Tringa nebularia* — (1) One at the Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria on day 8.

**Wood Sandpiper** *Tringa glareola* — (4) Scattered sightings at wetlands in Bulgaria.

Common Redshank Tringa totanus — (3) About 20 at the Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria on day 8.

#### **GULLS AND TERNS: Laridae (11)**

**Slender-billed Gull** *Chroicocephalus genei* — (2) About 30 at Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria on day 7, fewer there on day 8.

**Black-headed Gull** *Chroicocephalus ridibundus* — (10) Common and widespread, seen throughout. Flocks of 100+ in fields in Romania.

Little Gull Hydrocoloeus minutus — (2) Around 10 at Pomorie saltworks on days 7 and 8.

**Mediterranean Gull** *Ichthyaetus melanocephalus* — (6) Flocks of several 100 each seen on wetlands and farmland in Romania.

**Yellow-legged** Larus michahellis — (6) Very common along the coast in Bulgaria.

**Caspian Gull** Larus cachinnans — (3) Common in Romania, not seen in Bulgaria.

**Caspian Tern** *Hydroprogne caspia* — (4) Single birds seen over wetlands in both countries.

Whiskered Tern Chlidonias hybrida — (1) One near Lake Durankulak on day 6.

**Common Tern** Sterna hirundo — (3) Scattered sightings in both countries.

**Little Tern** Sternula albifrons — (1) Two seen at the Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria on day 8.

**Sandwich Tern** Thalasseus sandvicensis — (6) Scattered sightings in both countries. 100+ at Lake Shabla-Tuzla and Pomorie saltworks in Bulgaria.

#### STORKS: Ciconiidae (1)

**Black Stork** *Ciconia nigra* — (1) Two seen flying over the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, in Bulgaria, on day 8

#### **CORMORANTS: Phalacrocoracidae (3)**

**Pygmy Cormorant** *Microcarbo pygmaeus* — (8) Common on wetlands in both countries.

**Great Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax carbo* — (9) Common on wetlands in both countries.

**European Shag** Gulosus aristotelis — (3) Fairly common on rocky coastlines in Bulgaria.

#### PELICANS: Pelecanidae (2)

**Great White Pelican** *Pelecanus onocrotalus* — (2) About 30 on Lake Burgas-Vaya in Bulgaria on day 8.

**Dalmatian Pelican** *Pelecanus crispus* — (4) Scattered sightings in both countries.

#### **HERONS AND EGRETS: Ardeidae (4)**

**Gray Heron** *Ardea cinerea* — (8) Common. Scattered sightings in both countries.

**Purple Heron** Ardea purpurea - (5) Up to ten seen, often in flight, in both countries.

**Great Egret** Ardea alba — (8) Common. Scattered sightings in both countries.

**Little Egret** *Egretta garzetta* — (5) Scattered sightings, most in Bulgaria.

#### IBIS AND SPPONBILLS: Threskiornithidae (1)

**Eurasian Spoonbill** *Platalea leucorodia* — (2) One at Histria in Romania on day 2 and eight in flight over the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, in Bulgaria on day 8.

#### **OSPREY: Pandionidae (1)**

**Osprey** Pandion haliaetus — (3) Several individual migrating birds seen in both countries.

#### HAWKS, KITES AND EAGLES: Accipitridae (9)

**European Honey-Buzzard** *Pernis apivorus* — (1) Six on passage over the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, in Bulgaria on day 9.

**Short-toed Snake-Eagle** Circaetus gallicus — (1) Good views of a two different birds in Bulgaria on day 9, one perched near Primorsko and one in flight near Izvor.

**Lesser Spotted Eagle** - (2) Two seen in Bulgaria; one at Balchik on day 7 and one over the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, on day 8.

**Eurasian Marsh-Harrier** *Circus aeruginosus* — (10) Common, several seen every day: mainly females and immatures.

**Levant Sparrowhawk** *Accipiter brevipes* — (3) One at Histria on day 2 and one at Jurilovca on day 3, in Romania, and in Bulgaria two at Cape Kaliakra on day 5.

Eurasian Sparrowhawk Accipiter nisus — (7) Up to 10 seen on some days in both countries.

White-tailed Eagle Haliaeetus albicilla — (2) Three seen in Bulgaria; two at Durankulak on day 6 and one over the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, on day 9.

**Common Buzzard** Buteo buteo — (10) Widespread in both countries, often perched at roadsides.

**Long-legged Buzzard** *Buteo rufinus* — (3) Three seen; in Romania one near Sarichioi on day 3 and one near Baia on day 4, and in Bulgaria one over the Izvorska River Mouth, Lake Mandra, on day 8.

#### OWLS: Strigidae (1)

**Little Owl** Athene noctua - (2) Two seen: one at Histria, Romania, on day 2 and one on a village house chimney near Lake Mandra, Bulgaria, on day 8.

#### **HOOPOES: Upupidae (1)**

**Eurasian Hoopoe** *Upupa epops*  $\dots$  — (2) One at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3 and one near Shabla in Bulgaria on day 6.

#### **KINGFISHERS: Alcedinidae (1)**

**Common Kingfisher** Alcedo atthis — (2) Three at Durankulak on day 6 and one on day 8, all in Bulgaria.

#### **WOODPECKERS: Picidae (9)**

**Eurasian Wryneck** *Jynx torquilla* — (1) One by Lake Burgas-Vaya in Bulgaria on day 8.

**Middle-spotted Woodpecker** *Dendrocoptes medius* — (4) Several sightings in both countries.

**Great Spotted Woodpecker** *Dendrocopos major* — (5) Fairly common in both counties.

**Syrian Woodpecker** *Dendrocopos syriacus* — (7) Seen in settlements in both countries including two at our hotel in Baia in Romania on days 2 and 3.

White-backed Woodpecker Dendrocopos leucotos — (1) One seen in the Strandzha forest in Bulgaria on day 9: the southern European subspecies *lilfordi*.

**Lesser Spotted Woodpecker** *Dryobates minor* — (2) One at Durankulak in Bulgaria on day 4 and one heard in the Ropotamo forest on day 9.

**Gray-headed Woodpecker** *Picus canus* — (2) Seen in the woods around our hotel at Rosenets in Bulgaria on days 8 and 9.

**Eurasian Green Woodpecker** *Picus viridis* — (3) Five seen in total Bulgaria: in the Baltata Reserve on day 7, Rosenets on day 8 and the Strandzha Forest on day 9.

**Black Woodpecker** *Dryocopus martius* — (2) Two in Bulgaria: one in the Baltata Reserve on day 7 and one in the Strandzha Forest on day 9.

#### FALCONS: Falconidae (3)

**Eurasian Kestrel** Falco tinnunculus — (10) Common and widespread in both countries.

**Red-footed Falcon** Falco vespertinus — (3) A dozen seen hunting at Histria in Romania on day 2.

**Eurasian Hobby** Falco subbuteo — (4) Several sightings of migrating individuals in both countries.

## **SHRIKES: Laniidae (1)**

**Red-backed Shrike** *Lanius collurio* — (5) Many seen, mostly juveniles and females, in both countries.

#### **CROWS AND JAYS: Corvidae (6)**

**Eurasian Jay** *Garrulus glandarius* — (6) Many seen, often in flight, mostly in Bulgaria.

**Eurasian Magpie** *Pica pica* — (10) Common in both rural and urban habitats throughout.

Eurasian Jackdaw Corvus monedula — (10) Common in both rural and urban areas throughout.

**Rook** Corvus frugilegus — (7) Common. Flocks of 100s seen in farmland in Romania.

**Hooded Crow** *Corvus cornix* — (10) Common and widespread in both countries.

**Common Raven** Corvus corax — (2) Seen on days 8 and 9 in Bulgaria.

#### TITS AND CHICKADEES: Paridae (2)

Eurasian Blue Tit Cyanistes caeruleus — (1) One seen on day 3 at Baia in Romania.

**Great Tit** Parus major — (6) Fairly common in wooded places, especially in Bulgaria.

# LARKS: Alaudidae (2)

Eurasian Skylark Alauda arvensis — (1) Seen and heard in flight at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3.

**Crested Lark** *Galerida cristata* — (5) Scattered sightings in both countries, often at roadsides and around settlements. Eight at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3.

#### REED WARBLERS: Acrocephalidae (2)

Eurasian Reed Warbler Acrocephalus scirpaceus — (1) One at Lake Durankulak in Bulgaria on day 6.

Marsh Warbler Acrocephalus palustris — (1) One shown to us in the hand by a local bird bander at Lake Durankulak in Bulgaria on day 6.

#### **SWALLOWS AND MARTINS: Hirundinidae (4)**

**Bank Swallow** Riparia riparia — (4) A few occasionally seen with migrating Barn Swallows.

**Barn Swallow** *Hirundo rustica* — (10) Flocks seen on migration seen every day.

**Red-rumped Swallow** *Hirundo daurica* — (1) Three at Nessebar on day 7.

**Common House-Martin** *Delichon urbicum* — (3) Some amongst bigger flocks of Barn Swallows.

### **LEAF WARBLERS: Phylloscopidae (2)**

Willow Warbler Phylloscopus trochilus — (1) One seen on day 5 in Sveti Nikola in Bulgaria.

**Common Chiffchaff** *Phylloscopus collybita* — (6) Quite common, numerous sightings, and others heard, in both countries.

#### LONG-TAILED TITS: Aegithalidae (1)

Long-tailed Tit Aegithalos caudatus — (1) At least six seen in the Baltata Reserve in Bulgaria on day 7.

#### SYLVIID WARBLERS: Sylviidae (3)

**Eurasian Blackcap** *Sylvia atricapilla* — (2) Two seen on day 3 at Jurilovca in Romania and one on Cape Kaliakra, Bulgaria, on day 5.

**Lesser Whitethroat** *Curruca curruca* — (2) Seen at Histria in Romania on day 2 and at Cape Kaliakra, Lake Shabla-Tuzla and Sveti Nikola in Bulgaria on day 5.

Greater (Common) Whitethroat Curruca communis — (1) One seen by Lake Burgas-Vaya in Bulgaria on day 8.

#### **NUTHATCHES: Sittidae (1)**

**Eurasian Nuthatch** *Sitta europea* — (3) Seen on day 9 in the Ropotamo and Strandzha forests in Bulgaria: others heard.

# TREECREEPERS: Certhiidae (1)

**Short-toed Treecreeper** *Certhia brachydactyla* — (2) Seen in Bulgaria in the Baltata Reserve on day 7 and at Rosenets by our hotel on day 9.

#### **STARLINGS: Sturnidae (1)**

**European Starling** Sturnus vulgaris — (10) Common in both countries, often in big flocks.

# **THRUSHES: Turdidae (2)**

Song Thrush  $Turdus\ philomelos\ -$  (1) One on day 9 in the garden of our hotel in Rosenets in Bulgaria. Eurasian Blackbird  $Turdus\ merula\ -$  (2) Several on days 8 and 9 in the grounds of our hotel in Rosenets in Bulgaria.

#### OLD WORLD FLYCATCHERS AND CHATS: Muscicapidae (6)

**Spotted Flycatcher** *Muscicapa striata* — (6) Common in both countries, seen throughout.

**European Robin** *Erithacus rubecula* — (4) Several individual birds seen in Bulgaria.

**Red-breasted Flycatcher** *Ficedula hypoleuca* — (6) Many sightings of migrating birds.

**Common Redstart** *Phoenicurus phoenicurus* — (1) One seen on day 2 at Histria in Romania.

Black Redstart Phoenicurus ochruros — (2) Seen in Romania at Histria on day 2 and at Cheia on day 4.

Whinchat  $Saxicola\ rubetra$  — (1) One seen at Histria in Romania on day 2.

#### **OLD WORLD SPARROWS: Passeridae (3)**

**House Sparrow** *Passer domesticus* — (10) Common and widespread in both countries.

**Spanish Sparrow** Passer hispaniolensis — (2) 20 seen at Lake Shabla-Tuzla in Bulgaria on day 5.

**Eurasian Tree Sparrow** *Passer montanus* - (4) Only seen in rural areas, mainly in Romania.

#### PIPITS AND WAGTAILS: Motacillidae (3)

**Gray Wagtail** *Motacilla cinerea* — (1) Three seen on day 4 at Durankulak.

White Wagtail Motacilla alba — (10) Common and widespread. Many passage flocks seen.

**Tree Pipit** Anthus trivialis — (1) One seen at Jurilovca in Romania on day 3.

# FINCHES AND EUPHONIAS: Fringillidae (4)

**Common Chaffinch** *Fringilla coelebs* — (3) Seen in Bulgaria at Ropotamo, the Strandzha Forest, by Lake Mandra and in the hotel grounds at Rosenets.

European Greenfinch Chloris chloris — (2) Six seen at our hotel in Baia, Romania, on days 2 and 3.

**Eurasian Linnet** *Linaria cannabina* — (1) About 6 seen at a gas station between Bucharest and Constanta in Romania on day 1.

**European Goldfinch** Carduelis carduelis — (7) Common, small flocks seen in both countries.

#### **OLD WORLD BUNTINGS: Emberizidae (1)**

**Corn Bunting** *Emberiza calandra* — (2) Dozens in farmland and on roadside wires around Dobrich in Bulgaria on days 5 and 6.

#### **OTHER WILDLIFE:**

**Eurasian Red Squirrel** *Sciurus vulgaris* — (2) Singles seen on days 6 and 9 in Bulgaria.

**Roe Deer** Capreolus capreolus — (1) A group in a field by the highway on route to Sofia on day 10.

**Nutria (Coypu)** Myocastor coypus — (1) Two at Durankulak on day 6: an introduced, invasive, species.

European Pond Turtle Emys orbicularis — (1) Several seen on wetlands in Romania on day 2.

Praying Mantis Mantis religiosa — (1) A female found at Cheia, Romania, on day 4.

**Small White** *Pieris rapae* — (5)

**Eastern Bath White** *Pontia edusa* — (3)

**European Common Blue** *Polyommatus icarus* — (2)

**Sliver-washed Fritillary** *Argynnis paphia* — (1)

**Speckled Wood** *Pararge aegeria* — (1)
