

# Ohio: Biggest Week in Birding Species List | May 5 – 12, 2026 With Naturalist Journeys

Bird enthusiasts from California, Georgia, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nebraska, Virginia and Washington traveled to northern Ohio to experience the spring passage of Neotropical migrants, in particular warblers, along the Magee Marsh Boardwalk. Several visits to the boardwalk produced close up looks of several species of warblers and several other species too. For the week we tallied 24 species of warblers and numerous other species from multiple families including flycatchers, shorebirds, sparrows, swallows, thrushes, waders, waterfowl, woodpeckers and vireos.

BIRDS - 139 species were recorded of which five were heard only (HO) and three were introduced (I). Details are included below. (#) after the species indicates the number of days the species was seen on the tour.

## **Family or Species Common Name: Scientific Name**

### **DUCKS, GEESE, AND SWANS: Anatidae**

**Canada Goose** *Branta canadensis* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Trumpeter Swan** *Cygnus buccinator* — (5) Seen at Magee Marsh, Metzger Marsh and Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge (NWR).

**Wood Duck** *Aix sponsa* — (6) Seen at multiple locations.

**Blue-winged Teal** *Spatula discors* — (2) One seen at Metzger Marsh and another on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**Northern Shoveler** *Spatula clypeata* — (1) Seen at Metzger Marsh.

**Mallard** *Anas platyrhynchos* — (6) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Common Merganser** *Mergus merganser* — (1) Two were seen in flight at Cuyahoga Valley National Park (NP) near Station Road.

### **PARTRIDGES, PHEASANTS, AND ALLIES: Phasianidae**

**Wild Turkey** *Meleagris gallopavo* — (2) Seen twice en route at the same location near Oregon.

**PIGEONS AND DOVES: Columbidae**

**Rock Pigeon (I)** *Columba livia* — (1) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Mourning Dove** *Zenaida macroura* — (6) Common, seen and heard at multiple locations.

**NIGHTJARS AND ALLIES: Caprimulgidae**

**Eastern Whip-poor-will** *Antrostomus vociferus* — (2) One was seen in flight at Maumee Bay State Park and another from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**SWIFTS: Apodidae**

**Chimney Swift** *Chaetura pelagica* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**HUMMINGBIRDS: Trochilidae**

**Ruby-throated Hummingbird** *Archilochus colubris* — (3) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve, Magee Marsh Boardwalk, Oak Openings Metropark and Pearson Metropark.

**RAILS, COOTS, AND ALLIES: Rallidae**

**Sora** *Porzana carolina* — (3) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Common Gallinule** *Gallinula galeata* — (2) Heard at Metzger Marsh and seen on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**American Coot** *Fulica americana* — (1) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**CRANES: Gruidae**

**Sandhill Crane** *Antigone canadensis* — (4) Seen at Magee Marsh, Howard Marsh Metropark, Metzger Marsh and Ottawa NWR.

**STILTS AND AVOCETS: Recurvirostridae**

**Black-necked Stilt** *Himantopus mexicanus*— (2) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark and Metzger Marsh.

**PLOVERS AND LAPWINGS: Charadriidae**

**Killdeer** *Charadrius vociferus* — (6) Seen at multiple locations.

**SANDPIPERS AND ALLIES: Scolopacidae**

**American Woodcock** *Scolopax minor* — (2) Seen and heard at Maumee Bay State Park.

**Wilson's Phalarope** *Phalaropus tricolor* — (1) A male and female were seen together at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**Spotted Sandpiper** *Actitis macularius* — (2) Single birds were seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Howard Marsh Metropark.

**Solitary Sandpiper** *Tringa solitaria* — (1) A single bird was seen on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**Lesser Yellowlegs** *Tringa flavipes* — (2) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark and on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**Dunlin** *Calidris alpina* — (2) Approximately 150 were seen at Howard Marsh Metropark, with smaller numbers at Metzger Marsh and Ottawa NWR.

**Least Sandpiper** *Calidris minutilla* — (1) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**GULLS AND TERNS: Laridae**

**Ring-billed Gull** *Larus delawarensis* — (3) Seen at Wendy Park, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Howard Marsh Metropark.

**American Herring Gull** *Larus argentatus* — (3) Seen at the Rocky River Nature Center, Wendy Park, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Magee Marsh.

**Caspian Tern** *Hydroprogne caspia* — (1) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**Common Tern** *Sterna hirundo* — (3) Seen at multiple locations.

#### **GREBES: Podicipedidae**

**Pied-billed Grebe** *Podilymbus podiceps* — (1) Seen on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

#### **CORMORANTS: Phalacrocoracidae**

**Double-crested Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax auritus* — (3) Seen at multiple locations.

#### **HERONS AND EGRETS: Ardeidae**

**Snowy Egret** *Egretta thula* — (2) Single birds seen at Howard Marsh Metropark and Magee Marsh.

**Green Heron** *Butorides virescens* — (4) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Great Egret** *Ardea alba* — (7) Seen at multiple locations.

**Great Blue Heron** *Ardea herodias* — (6) Seen at multiple locations, including 25+ at a rookery in Cuyahoga Valley NP.

#### **PELICANS: Pelecanidae**

**American White Pelican** *Pelecanus erythrorhynchos* — (5) Seen in flight near the Magee Marsh Visitor Center and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

#### **NEW WORLD VULTURES: Cathartidae**

**Turkey Vulture** *Cathartes aura* — (6) Common, seen at multiple locations.

#### **OSPREY: Pandionidae**

**Osprey** *Pandion haliaetus* — (5) Seen at Wendy Park, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve, Howard Marsh Metropark and Magee Marsh.

#### **HAWKS, KITES, AND EAGLES: Accipitridae**

**Sharp-shinned Hawk** *Accipiter striatus* — (1) A single bird was seen in flight at Cuyahoga Valley NP from Bath Road.

**Cooper's Hawk** *Accipiter cooperii* — (3) Single birds seen at Ottawa NWR and Oak Openings Metropark.

**Northern Harrier** *Circus hudsonius* — (1) A single bird was seen in flight on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**Bald Eagle** *Haliaeetus leucocephalus* — (6) Seen at multiple locations.

**Broad-winged Hawk** *Buteo platypterus* — (2) Seen in Cuyahoga Valley NP and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Red-shouldered Hawk** *Buteo lineatus* — (1) A single bird was seen in flight in Cuyahoga Valley NP.

**Red-tailed Hawk** *Buteo jamaicensis* — (4) Seen in Cuyahoga Valley NP, Oak Openings Metropark and Ottawa NWR.

#### **OWLS: Strigidae**

**Eastern Screech-Owl** *Megascops asio* — (1) A single bird was seen at Ottawa NWR.

**Northern Saw-whet Owl** *Aegolius acadicus* — (1) A single bird was seen perched at eye level in a small tree less than six feet from the boardwalk at Magee Marsh.

#### **KINGFISHERS: Alcedinidae**

**Belted Kingfisher** *Megaceryle alcyon* — (2) Single birds were seen at Rocky River Reservation and at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

### **WOODPECKERS: Picidae**

**Red-headed Woodpecker** *Melanerpes erythrocephalus* — (7) Seen at multiple locations.

**Red-bellied Woodpecker** *Melanerpes carolinus* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Downy Woodpecker** *Dryobates pubescens* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Hairy Woodpecker** *Dryobates villosus* — (2) Single birds were seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP near Station Road and at Ottawa NWR.

**Pileated Woodpecker** *Dryocopus pileatus* — (2) HO, at the Ledges in Cuyahoga Valley NP and at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Northern Flicker** *Colaptes auratus* — (6) Seen at multiple locations.

### **FALCONS AND CARACARAS: Falconidae**

**American Kestrel** *Falco sparverius* — (2) Single birds were seen en route to Oak Harbor and at Oak Openings Metropark.

### **TYRANT FLYCATCHERS: Tyrannidae**

**Least Flycatcher** *Empidonax minimus* — (2) Seen and heard from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Eastern Phoebe** *Sayornis phoebe* — (2) Seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP and Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Great Crested Flycatcher** *Myiarchus crinitus* — (2) HO, at Ottawa NWR and Oak Openings Metropark.

**Eastern Kingbird** *Tyrannus tyrannus* — (5) Seen at multiple locations.

### **VIREOS: Vireonidae**

**White-eyed Vireo** *Vireo griseus* — (1) A single bird was seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Yellow-throated Vireo** *Vireo flavifrons* — (1) Seen and heard at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Blue-headed Vireo** *Vireo solitarius* — (4) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cuyahoga Valley NP, Oak Openings Metropark and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Eastern Warbling Vireo** *Vireo gilvus* — (6) Common, seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Red-eyed Vireo** *Vireo olivaceus* — (1) A single bird was seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP near Station Road.

### **CROWS AND JAYS: Corvidae**

**Blue Jay** *Cyanocitta cristata* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations with large numbers seen moving back and forth along Lake Erie at Magee Marsh.

**American Crow** *Corvus brachyrhynchos* — (3) Seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP and Oak Openings.

### **TITS AND CHICKADEES: Paridae**

**Black-capped Chickadee** *Poecile atricapillus* — (4) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Tufted Titmouse** *Baeolophus bicolor* — (5) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

### **SWALLOWS AND MARTINS: Hirundinidae**

**Bank Swallow** *Riparia riparia* — (1) A single bird was seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Tree Swallow** *Tachycineta bicolor* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Purple Martin** *Progne subis* — (5) Seen at multiple locations with largest numbers at Metzger Marsh and the Ottawa NWR Visitor Center.

**Northern Rough-winged Swallow** *Stelgidopteryx serripennis* — (4) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Ottawa NWR.

**Barn Swallow** *Hirundo rustica* — (6) Common, seen at multiple locations.

### **KINGLETS: Regulidae**

**Ruby-crowned Kinglet** *Regulus calendula* — (5) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

### **NUTHATCHES: Sittidae**

**White-breasted Nuthatch** *Sitta carolinensis* — (4) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Red-breasted Nuthatch** *Sitta canadensis* — (3) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

### **CREEPERS: Certhiidae**

**Brown Creeper** *Certhia americana* — (1) HO, at Cuyahoga Valley NP near Station Road.

### **GNATCATCHERS: Polioptilidae**

**Blue-gray Gnatcatcher** *Polioptila caerulea* — (6) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

### **WRENS: Troglodytidae**

**Northern House Wren** *Troglodytes aedon* — (5) Common, seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Marsh Wren** *Cistothorus palustris* — (2) HO, at Metzger Marsh and on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**Carolina Wren** *Thryothorus ludovicianus* — (5) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

### **STARLINGS AND MYNAS: Sturnidae**

**European Starling (I)** *Sturnus vulgaris* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

### **MOCKINGBIRDS AND THRASHERS: Mimidae**

**Gray Catbird** *Dumetella carolinensis* — (6) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Northern Mockingbird:** *Mimus polyglottos* — (2) One was heard at the Beaver Marsh in Cuyahoga Valley NP and another was seen at Oak Openings Metropark.

### **THRUSHES: Turdidae**

**Eastern Bluebird** *Sialia sialis* — (1) Seen at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Veery** *Catharus fuscescens* — (2) Single birds were seen along the entrance road to the Ledges area in Cuyahoga Valley NP and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Gray-cheeked Thrush** *Catharus minimus* — (1) A single bird was seen at Pearson Metropark.

**Wood Thrush** *Hylocichla mustelina* — (1) Seen and heard from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**American Robin** *Turdus migratorius* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

### **OLD WORLD SPARROWS: Passeridae**

**House Sparrow (I)** *Passer domesticus* — (7) Seen at multiple locations.

### **FINCHES AND EUPHONIAS: Fringillidae**

**House Finch** *Haemorhous mexicanus* — (3) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cuyahoga Valley NP and at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**American Goldfinch** *Spinus tristis* — (7) Seen at multiple locations.

### **NEW WORLD SPARROWS: Passerellidae**

**Chipping Sparrow** *Spizella passerina* — (4) Heard and seen at multiple locations.

**Field Sparrow** *Spizella pusilla* — (2) Heard and seen at Oak Openings Metropark and on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

**Lark Sparrow** *Chondestes grammacus* — (1) Seen at Oak Openings Metropark.

**White-crowned Sparrow** *Zonotrichia leucophrys* — (1) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Harris's Sparrow** *Zonotrichia querula* — (1) An adult in breeding plumage was seen in the parking lot of the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**White-throated Sparrow** *Zonotrichia albicollis* — (5) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve, Pearson Metropark and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Song Sparrow** *Melospiza melodia* — (7) Common, seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Lincoln's Sparrow** *Melospiza lincolni* — (1) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Swamp Sparrow** *Melospiza georgiana* — (5) Heard and seen at multiple locations.

**Eastern Towhee** *Pipilo erythrophthalmus* — (2) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Oak Openings Metropark.

#### **YELLOW-BREASTED CHAT: Icteriidae**

**Yellow-breasted Chat** *Icteria virens* — (2) One was heard and seen at Oak Openings Metropark and another heard from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

#### **NEW WORLD BLACKBIRDS: Icteridae**

**Eastern Meadowlark** *Sturnella magna* — (1) Two were seen together at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Orchard Oriole** *Icterus spurius* — (1) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Baltimore Oriole** *Icterus galbula* — (6) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Red-winged Blackbird** *Agelaius phoeniceus* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Brown-headed Cowbird** *Molothrus ater* — (7) Seen at multiple locations.

**Rusty Blackbird** *Euphagus carolinus* — (1) A single bird was seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Common Grackle** *Quiscalus quiscula* — (6) Seen at multiple locations.

#### **NEW WORLD WARBLERS: Parulidae**

**Louisiana Waterthrush** *Parkesia motacilla* — (1) HO, at Cuyahoga Valley NP near Station Road.

**Northern Waterthrush** *Parkesia noveboracensis* — (4) Seen at Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Golden-winged Warbler** *Vermivora chrysoptera* — (1) A single bird was heard and briefly seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Blue-winged Warbler** *Vermivora cyanoptera* — (1) Three were heard and seen at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Black-and-white Warbler** *Mniotilta varia* — (3) Seen at Rocky River Reservation and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Prothonotary Warbler** *Protonotaria citrea* — (3) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Tennessee Warbler** *Orethlypis peregrina* — (3) Heard at Rocky River Reservation and seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Nashville Warbler** *Orethlypis ruficapilla* — (6) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Common Yellowthroat** *Geothlypis trichas* — (5) Heard and seen at multiple locations.

**Hooded Warbler** *Setophaga citrina* — (1) Heard and seen at Oak Openings Metropark.

**American Redstart** *Setophaga ruticilla* — (5) Seen at multiple locations.

**Cape May Warbler** *Setophaga tigrina* — (5) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Northern Parula** *Setophaga americana* — (3) Heard and seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk and heard at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Magnolia Warbler** *Setophaga magnolia* — (3) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Blackburnian Warbler** *Setophaga fusca* — (3) Seen at Rocky River Reservation and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Northern Yellow Warbler** *Setophaga petechia* — (7) Common, seen at multiple locations.

**Chestnut-sided Warbler** *Setophaga pensylvanica* — (2) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk and heard at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Black-throated Blue Warbler** *Setophaga caerulescens* — (4) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk and at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Palm Warbler** *Setophaga palmarum* — (5) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Metzger Marsh and from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Pine Warbler** *Setophaga pinus* — (2) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk and heard at Oak Openings Metropark.

**Yellow-rumped Warbler** *Setophaga coronata* — (6) Seen at multiple locations.

**Yellow-throated Warbler** *Setophaga dominica* — (1) Heard and seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP near Station Rd.

**Black-throated Green Warbler** *Setophaga virens* — (4) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk and heard at the Ledges in Cuyahoga Valley NP.

**Wilson's Warbler** *Cardellina pusilla* — (2) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

### CARDINALS, GROSBEAKS, AND ALLIES: Cardinalidae

**Scarlet Tanager** *Piranga olivacea* — (4) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk and great looks were had of a male on the edge of the parking lot.

**Northern Cardinal** *Cardinalis cardinalis* — (7) Common, seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Rose-breasted Grosbeak** *Pheucticus ludovicianus* — (5) Seen and heard at multiple locations.

**Indigo Bunting** *Passerina cyanea* — (3) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk, Oak Openings Metropark and heard on the Ottawa NWR Wildlife Drive.

### MAMMALS

**Eastern Cottontail** *Sylvilagus floridanus* — (3) Seen at Maumee Bay SP, Magee Marsh and Ottawa NWR.

**Eastern Chipmunk** *Tamias striatus* — (4) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cuyahoga Valley NP, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Oak Openings Metropark.

**American Red Squirrel** *Tamiasciurus hudsonicus* — (3) Seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP, Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve and Oak Openings Metropark.

**Eastern Gray Squirrel** *Sciurus carolinensis* — (3) Seen at Rocky River Reservation, Cuyahoga Valley NP and Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve.

**Fox Squirrel** *Sciurus niger* — (4) Seen at multiple locations.

**Woodchuck** *Marmota monax* — (1) One was seen while driving through the Cleveland Cultural Gardens.

**Muskrat** *Ondatra zibethicus* — (4) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark, Magee Marsh and Ottawa NWR.

**Common Raccoon** *Procyon lotor* — (2) Seen at Maumee Bay SP.

**White-tailed Deer** *Odocoileus virginianus* — (4) Seen at Maumee Bay SP.

**American Bullfrog** *Lithobates catesbeianus* — (1) HO, at Magee Marsh.

**Green Frog** *Lithobates clamitans* — (1) HO, at the Cuyahoga Valley NP.

**Painted Turtle** *Chrysemys picta* — (4) Seen at multiple locations.

**Red-eared Slider** *Trachemys scripta elegans* — (1) Seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP.

**Common Snapping Turtle** *Chelydra serpentina* — (2) Seen at Cuyahoga Valley NP and at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**Blanding's Turtle** *Emydoidea blandingii* — (1) Seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk.

**Common Garter Snake** *Thamnophis sirtalis* — (1) Seen at Pearson Metropark.

**Northern Water Snake** *Nerodia sipedon* — (1) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**Eastern Rat Snake** *Pantherophis obsoletus* — (1) Seen near the Optics Alley tent at Magee Marsh.
