## Annotated Bird Species List

Sites visited on Trinidad included: Asa Wright Nature Centre, Blanchisseuse Road of the Northern Range, Brasso Seco, the Aripo Agricultural Station, Arena Forest, Nariva Swamp, the abandoned Waller Field airstrip, Caroni National Park, and Yerette Hummingbird Garden. On Tobago, three sites were featured: Cuffie River Nature Retreat, Gilpin Trace on the Main Ridge Preserve, and Little Tobago Island.

Black-bellied Whistling Duck Dendrocygna autumnalis – A few seen en-route to Nariva Swamp Rufous-vented Chachalaca Ortalis ruficauda – Abundant at Cuffie River Retreat, Tobago Trinidad Piping-Guan Pipile pipile - One seen near the Scatter station on the Blanchisseuse road Audubon's Shearwater (nest only) Puffinus Iherminieri - Our quide "Z" pointed out the nest-hole in a bank on Little Tobago Island Red-billed Tropicbird Phaethon aethereus – Hundreds on cliffs of Little Tobago Island Brown Booby Sula leucogaster – Abundant all around Little Tobago Island Red-footed Booby Sula sula – A few nesting on cliffs of Little Tobago Island Brown Pelican Pelicanus occidentalis - Seen in coastal Tobago **Neotropic Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax brasilianus* – Seen at the Caroni Marsh Anhinga Anhinga anhinga - Seen on the way to Nariva Swamp Magnificent Frigatebird Freqata magnificens – First one seen at the Aripo Livestock Station; many over Tobago - especially on Little Tobago Island harassing Red-billed Tropic Birds Great Blue Heron Ardea herodias – Seen on the wetlands before Caroni Marsh Great Egret Ardea alba - Several seen in wetland areas on Trinidad **Snowy Egret** *Egretta thula* – Common in Caroni National park Little Blue Heron Egretta caerulea – On both islands **Tricolored Heron** Egretta tricolor – Hundreds heading to roost with Scarlet Ibis at Caroni National Park **Cattle Egret** Bubulcus ibis – Common roadside bird and denizen of agricultural areas Striated Heron Butorides striata - One hunting at just before Nariva Swamp area

Yellow-crowned Night-Heron Nyctanassa violacea – Caroni National Park Boat-billed Heron Nycticorax nycticorax – Two flew over just as we got off the boat at Caroni National Park Scarlet Ibis Eudocimus ruber – Thousands in spectacular roosting display at Caroni N.P. Black Vulture Coragyps atratus – Many seen most days on Trinidad Turkey Vulture Cathartes aura – Common on Trinidad Osprey Pandion haliaetus - At Caroni National Park and at Little Tobago Island **Double-toothed Kite** Harpagus bidentatus – One in the scope at AWNC in the morning of second day Long-winged Harrier Circus buffoni – At wetland area before Caroni Marsh Gray-lined (Gray) Hawk Buteo nitida – Several seen on Trinidad **Common Black Hawk** Buteogallus anthracinus – Seen most days on Trinidad – even on verandah at AWNC Savanna Hawk Buteogallus meridionalis – Several on Trinidad, especially at Aripo Livestock Station **Broad-winged Hawk** Buteo platypterus – One seen at the Tropicbird overlook on Little Tobago Zone-tailed Hawk Buteo albonotatus – One seen at close range on savannah over Trinidad Ornate Hawk Eagle Spizaetus ornatus – Soaring over Northern Range, Trinidad Yellow-headed Caracara Milvago chimachima – A few seen at Aripo Livestock Station, also on Cocoanut Alley on the way to Nariva Swamp Merlin Falco columbarius - One at Aripo Livestock Station Aplomado Falcon Falco femoralis - One at Aripo Livestock Station **Peregrine Falcon** Falco peregrinus – One seen roosting at Aripo Livestock Station at night Gray-necked Wood-Rail Aramides cajaneus - Two seen in the dark roosting at Caroni Southern Lapwing Vanellus chilensis – Common in wet agricultural fields on Trinidad Wattled Jacana Jacana jacana – Common in wetlands on Trinidad, Especially at Aripo Livestock Station Solitary Sandpiper Tringa solitaria – Several in moist agricultural fields, Trinidad Spotted Sandpiper Actitis macularius – Common in wetlands and along shorelines - both islands Ruddy Turnstone Arenaria interpres - On the beach at Blue Waters Inn, Tobago Least Sandpiper Calidris minutilla – On sandbar at Caroni Marsh Laughing Gull Leucophaeus atricilla - At a coastal pullover on Tobago Royal Tern Thalasseus maximus – Several dozen seen off dock in Atlantic Ocean, Tobago Rock (Feral) Pigeon Columba livia – Urban areas on Trinidad Pale-vented Pigeon Patagioenas cayennensis - Many seen on Tobago Scaled Pigeon Patagioenas speciosa - Seen at the Scatter Station on Trinidad's Northern Range Eared Dove Zenaida auriculata - Several seen on Tobago Ruddy Ground Dove Columbina talpacoti – Common in urban and rural areas of Trinidad White-tipped Dove Leptotila verreauxi – Common in forested areas of Tobago Gray-fronted Dove Leptotila rufaxilla –Under feeders at AWNC the first day, Trinidad Red-bellied Macaw Orthopsittaca manilata - Two seen roosting at the abandoned airstrip, Trinidad Green-rumped Parrolet Forpus passerines – Several in tree top at agricultural station, also in metal pole

Green-rumped Parrolet Forpus passerines – Several in tree top at agricultural station, also in metal pole on Savannah

Orange-winged Parrot Amazona amazonica – Seen and heard daily on both islands Squirrel Cuckoo Playa cayana – One seen at the Scatter Station off the Blanchisseuse Road Striped Cuckoo Tapera naevia- At Nariva Swamp

Smooth-billed Ani Crotophaga ani – Common road and trailside bird on both islands Tropical Screech Owl Megascops choliba – One in a tree at the Aripo Livestock Station, Trinidad Ferruginous Pygmy-Owl Glaucidium brasilianum – Calling at AWNC and on the Blanchisseuse Road **Striped Owl** *Pseudoscops clamator* - One heard then seen by a few as it flew over Cuffie R. R. at dusk **Common Pauraque** *Nyctidromus albicollis* – Along road at night at Aripo Livestock Station, Trinidad **White-tailed Nightjar** *Caprimulgus cayennensis* – Livestock station on Trinidad; Cuffie River Retreat **Common Potoo** *Nyctibius griseus* –Livestock Station, Caroni National Park, and Cuffie River Retreat **Oilbird** *Steatornis caripensis* – in Dunston Cave behind AWNC

Short-tailed Swift Chaetura brachyuran – Flocks seen on both islands over wetlands and streams **Band-rumped Swift** *Chaetura spinicaudus* – Seen off the verandah at AWNC

**Gray-rumped Swift** *Chaetura cinereiventris* – Common, seen on both islands

Fork-tailed Palm-Swift Tachornis squamata - A few seen at the abandoned airstrip on Trinidad

Rufous-breasted Hermit Glaucis hirsutus – Seen at feeders a t AWNC

Green Hermit Phaethornis guy – On feeders and in Trinidad forests

Little Hermit Phaethornis longuemareus - Seen at AWNC feeders

White-tailed Saberwing *Campylopterus ensipennis* – Cuffie R.R. feeders and on Gilpen Trace Trail White-necked Jacobin *Florisuga mellivora* – Ever-present on feeders on both islands

**Green-throated Mango** Anthracothorax viridigula – At Caroni Marsh

Black-throated Mango Anthracothorax nigricollis – On feeders and countryside of Trinidad Ruby-topaz Hummingbird Chrysolampis mosquitus - At AWNC and at Yerette Hummingbird Sanctuary Tufted Coquette Lophornis ornatus – AWNC feeders and flowers; Yerette Hummingbird Sanctuary Blue-chinned Sapphire Chlorestes notate – Common at AWNC and Yerette feeders White-chested Emerald Amazilia brevirostris – Most common hummingbird seen on Trinidad Copper-rumped Hummingbird Amazilia tobaci – Most common hummingbird on Tobago, also common

on Trinidad

Long-billed Starthroat Heliomaster longirostris –Visitor to AWNC feeders and surrounds Green-backed Trogon Trogon viridis – One seen along the Blanchisseuse Road in Trinidad

Collared Trogon Trogon collaris - On the way up the Northern Range, Trinidad

**Trinidad (Blue-crowned) Motmot** *Momotus (momota) bahamensis* – Common around both lodges: AWNC and Cuffie River, plus in rainforest areas on both islands

**Ringed Kingfisher** *Megaceryle torquata* – Roadside bird seen on way to Caroni Marsh **Green Kingfisher** *Chloroceryle americana* - Brief view at river near Nariva Swamp; some saw at Cuffie River NR

American Pygmy Kingfisher Chloroceryle aenea – Low in Mangroves, Caroni N.P. Also by Nariva at river Rufous-tailed Jacamar Galbula ruficauda – At Brasso Seco; more at Cuffie River Retreat

Channel-billed Toucan Ramphastos vitellinus – In tree tops behind AWNC

**Red-crowned Woodpecker** *Melanerpes rubricapillus* – On hummingbird feeders at Cuffie River NR **Red-rumped Woodpecker** *Verniliornis kirkii* - Along Blanchisseuse Rd. and at Gilpen Trace, Tobago **Golden-Olive Woodpecker** *Colaptes rubiginosus* –On AWNC grounds

Lineated Woodpecker Dryocopus lineatus – On AWNC grounds

Stripe-breasted Spinetail Synallaxis cinnamomea – AWNC Discovery trail

Yellow-chinned Spinetail Certhiaxis cinnamomeus – Arima Agriculture Station, Trinidad

Streaked Xenops Xenops rutilans - Along the Blanchisseuse Rd, Trinidad

Gray-throated Leaftosser Sclerurus albigularis – On hike up hill at Cuffie R.R., Tobago, nest

Straight-billed Woodcreeper Dendroplex picus – Caroni Marsh, Trinidad

Cocoa Woodcreeper Xiphorhynchus susurrans - Along the Blanchisseuse Rd, Trinidad

Great Antshrike Taraba major - One at the Scatter Station and one right at AWNC along driveway

Black-crested Antshrike Sakesphorus canadensis – near Nariva Swamp, Trinidad

Barred Antshrike Thamnophilus doliatus - Common at AWNC and other places

Plain Antvireo Dysithamnus mentalis – Brief looks along Blanchisseuse Rd

White-flanked Antwren Myrmotherula axillaris - Savannah, Trinidad White-fringed Antwren Formicivora grisea – Cuffie River Retreat, Tobago White-bellied Antbird Myrmeciza longpipes – Along the Discovery trail, AWNC, Trinidad Black-faced Antthrush Formicarius analis – Northern Range, Trinidad Southern Beardless-Tyrannulet Camptostoma obsoletum – Aripo Livestock Station, Trinidad Yellow-bellied Elaenia Elaenia flavogaster – Seen at a few spots both on Trinidad and Tobago Olive-striped Flycatcher Mionectes strepera - brief view along the Blanchisseuse Rd, Trinidad Ochre-bellied Flycatcher Mionectes oleaginous – AWNC, Northern Range, Trinidad **Slaty-capped Flycatcher** *Leptopogon superciliaris* - One seen along the Blanchisseuse Rd. Yellow-breasted Flycatcher Empidonax flaviventris – Along the road near Cuffie R. R. White-winged Becard Pachyramphus polychopterus – At Cuffie R. R., pair building nest Black-tailed Tityra Tityra cayana - seen at Brasso Seco Bearded Bellbird Procnia averano – Seen and heard at AWNC White-bearded Manakin Manacus manacus – Seen in AWNC vicinity Blue-backed Manakin Chiroxiphia pareola – Gilpin Rainforest Trail and trail near Cuffie R. R. Golden-headed Manakin Pipra erythrocephala – Rainforest behind AWNC Red-eyed (Chivi) Vireo Vireo olivaceus (chivi) - Heard many and saw on road by Cuffie R. R. Golden-fronted Greenlet Hylophilus qurantifrons – rain forest along Blanchisseuse Rd Rufous-browed Peppershrike Cyclarhis gujanensis – Aripo Savannah Gray-breasted Martin Progne chalybea – Northern Range, Trinidad White-winged Swallow Tachycineta albiventer – Seen on a few days around Savannah, Trinidad Southern Rough-winged Swallow Steigidopteryx ruficollis – Aripo Savannah, Trinidad Rufous-breasted Wren Pheugopedius rutilus – Common bird in AWNC rain forest House Wren Troglodytes aedon – Common near both lodges on both islands Yellow-legged Thrush Platycichia flavipes – Gilpin Rainforest, Tobago Cocoa Thrush Turdus fumigates – AWNC grounds, Northern Range, Trinidad Spectacled Thrush Turdus nudigenis – Almost daily visitor at feeders, both islands White-necked Thrush Turdus albicollis – Common rainforest bird on both islands Tropical Mockingbird Mimus gilvus – Seen and heard daily on both islands **Tropical Parula** *Parula pitiayumi* – AW rainforest, Northern Range Yellow Warbler Dendroica petechia - Arena Forest while we were having a picnic lunch

Northern Waterthrush Parkesia noveboracensis – Brief view in Savannah wetland, guide only? Masked Yellowthroat Geotlypis aequinoctialis – Aripo Savannah, Trinidad Golden-crowned Warbler Basileuterus culicivorus – AWNC rainforest, Northern Range, Trinidad

**Bananaquit** *Coereba flaveola* – One of most common birds of trip in most habitats and always on feeders

**Bicolored Conebill** Conirostrum bicolor – by stream on way to Nariva Swamp, Trinidad White-lined Tanager Tachyphonus rufus – Almost daily forest bird on both islands Red-crowned Ant-Tanager Habia rubica - in Northern Range and Savanna on Trinidad Hepatic Tanager Piranga flava - Northern Range, Trinidad Silver-beaked Tanager Ramphocelus carbo – Common forest bird on Trinidad Blue-gray Tanager Thraupis episcopus – Seen daily in most habitats on both islands **Palm Tanager** Thraupis palmarum – Daily birds perching in tree tops on both islands **Turquoise Tanager** Tangara mexicana – Northern Range forest canopy, Trinidad Speckled Tanager Tangara guttata – Northern Range forest, Trinidad **Bay-headed Tanager** Tangara gyrola – AWNC grounds and Northern Range, Trinidad Blue Dacnis Dacnis cayana - Seen on Trinidad in multiple habitats Green Honeycreeper Chlorophanes spiza – Daily feeder bird at AWNC Purple Honeycreeper Cyanerpes caeruleus – Daily AWNC feeder visitor Red-legged Honeycreeper Cyanerpes cyaneus – At AWNC and wayside stop on Tobago Blue-black Grassquit Volatinia jacarina – Nariva Swamp on Trinidad Sooty Grassguit Tiaris fuliginosus - Savannah on Trinidad Black-faced Grassquit Tiaris bicolor – In grassy tufts and fence alongside road on Tobago Grassland Yellow-Finch Sicalis luteola – Arima Agricultural Station, Trinidad Grayish Saltator Saltator coerulescens - Aripo Savannah, Trinidad Yellow-hooded Blackbird Chrysomus icterocephalus – Nariva Swamp, Trinidad Red-breasted Blackbird Sturnella militaris – Arima Agricultural Station, Trinidad Carib Grackle Quiscalus lugubris - Common roadside bird, Trinidad Shiny Cowbird Molothrus bonariensis – Arima Agricultural Station, Trinidad Giant Cowbird Molothrus oryzivorus - On trail near Cuffie R. This ten-day Classic Two Island tour was organized by Caligo Ventures and led by expert local guide David Ramlal from the Asa Wright Nature Centre (AWNC), on Trinidad and by Gladwyn James and Cuffie River's lead guide, Desmond, on Tobago. Six nights at AWNC allowed for field trips around the island. Tour escort Dodie Logue provides a lively narrative which can be found on caligo.com. 182 species were recorded.

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
