BIRDS

- 1. Western Grebe Aechmophorus occidentalis Seen on Yellowstone and Jackson Lakes
- 2. American White Pelican *Pelecanus erythrorhynchos* Common on Yellowstone/Jackson Lakes and Snake River
- 3. Double-crested Cormorant Phalacrocorax auritus Seen at Oxbow Bend. Snake River
- 4. Great Blue Heron Ardea Herodias Seen on Yellowstone and Jackson Lakes
- 5. Canada Goose Branta Canadensis Seen first three days on lakes and rivers
- 6. American Wigeon Anas Americana Same as above
- 7. Mallard Anas platyrhynchos Same as above
- 8. Cinnamon Teal Anas cyanoptera On Yellowstone River in Hayden Valley
- 9. Northern Pintail Anas acuta On Yellowstone Lake
- 10. Green-winged Teal Anas crecca On Yellowstone River in Hayden Valley
- 11. Lesser Scaup Aythya affini On Yellowstone Lake
- 12. Bufflehead Bucephala albeola Same as above
- 13. Barrow's Goldeneye Bucephala islandica Common on Yellowstone Lake and River
- 14. Common Merganser Mergus merganser On Jackson Lake and Snake River
- 15. Ruddy Duck Oxyura jamaicensis On small lake near Sylvan Pass
- 16. Turkey Vulture Cathartes aura Common on drive to Cody, Wyo and back to Billings
- 17. Osprey *Pandion haliaetus* Seen daily on lakes, rivers and ponds
- 18. Red-tailed Hawk Buteo jamaicensis Roadside bird seen on most days
- 19. Swainson's Hawk Buteo Swainsoni Soaring over Lake Butte
- 20. Bald Eagle Haliaeetus leucocephalus Flew overhead at Oxbow Bend, Snake River
- 21. Golden Eagle Aquila chrysaetos Sitting in field near Old Faithful; on snow bank in Beartooths
- 22. American Kestrel Falco sparverius Perched and flew beside Beartooth Pass Highway
- 23. Wild Turkey Meleagris gallopavo One walked nonchalantly across highway near Joliet, Mont.
- 24. Sora Porzana carolina Heard clearly in marsh lands near Yellowstone Lake
- 25. Sandhill Crane Charadrius semipalmatus Seen in Hayden Valley and Willow Flats
- 26. Spotted Sandpiper Actitis macularius Gravel bars along Snake, Yellowstone and Lamar Rivers
- 27. Wilson's Phalarope Phalaropus tricolor One spinning tight circles on pond in Hayden Valley
- 28. California Gull Larus californicus Numerous on Yellowstone Lake
- 29. Common Tern Sterna hirundo One seen on east shore of Yellowstone Lake

- 30. Broad-tailed Hummingbird *Selasphorus platycercus* At Oxbow Bend, Snake River in flowers; in Silver Gate, Montana
- 31. Hairy Woodpecker *Picoides villosus* Near Sylvan Pass
- 32. Northern Flicker Colaptes auratus Roadside bird seen most days
- 33. Western Wood Pewee Contopus sordidulus Common flycatcher often perched in burn areas
- 34. Willow Flycatcher *Empidonax traillii* Perched, fly-catching and calling at Oxbow Bend and near Jackson Lake in riparian vegetation.
- 35. Warbling Vireo Vireo gilvus Commonly heard in riparian vegetation near Yellowstone and Jackson Lakes
- 36. Gray Jay Perisoreus canadensis Several seen near Yellowstone Lake
- 37. Clark's Nutcracker Nucifraga columbiana Seen at Lakes Lodge and on Beartooth Highway
- 38. Black-billed Magpie Pica hudsonia Common road bird in arid, agricultural and urban lowlands
- 39. Common Raven Corvus corax Seen most days; One pair nested at Old Faithful lodge building!
- 40. Tree Swallow Tachycineta bicolor Abundant near water where dead trees provide nesting holes
- 41. Violet-green Swallow Tachycineta thalassina Over Yellowstone Lake and around Cooke City, Montana
- 42. Northern Rough-winged Swallow Stelgidopteryx serripennis Along Jackson Lake and at Old Faithfull
- 43. Cliff Swallow *Petrochelidon pyrrhonota* Seen almost daily near nest colonies under bridges and on rock formations
- 44. Barn Swallow Hirundo rustica Only seen in Grand Teton National Park
- 45. Mountain Chickadee *Poecile gambeli* Common in Lamar Valley, Beartooths and near Cooke City, Montana
- 46. Golden-crowned Kinglet Regulus satrapa On hike to Trout Lake, Yellowstone Park
- 47. Ruby-crowned Kinglet Regulus calendula Seen and heard daily
- 48. Mountain Bluebird Sialia currucoides At Lake Butte, in geyser basins and on Beartooth Highway
- 49. Townsend's Solitaire Myadestes townsendi One seen near Sylvan Pass
- 50. Swainson's Thrush Catharus ustulatus In deep, moist forest near Silver Gate and at Trout Lake
- 51. Hermit Thrush Catharus cattatus On Dunraven Pass Trail
- 52. American Robin Turdus migratorius Ubiquitous bird seen daily in most habitats
- 53. Cedar Waxwing Bombycilla cedrorum Seen on Trout Lake hike
- 54. MacGillivray's Warbler Geothlypis tolmiei Great look at Oxbow Bend, Snake River in Willows
- 55. Yellow Warbler Setophaga petechia Fairly common in riparian zones
- 56. Yellow-rumped Warbler Setophaga coronate Near Island Lakes in Beartooth Mountains
- 57. Wilson's Warbler Cardellina pusilla Along Yellowstone Lake and Lewis River
- 58. Chipping Sparrow Spizella passerine Seen and heard most days
- 59. Savannah Sparrow *Passerculus sandwichensis* Found near Yellowstone Lake, Lamar Valley and in open areas east of Cooke City
- 60. Song Sparrow Melospiza melodia Seen and heard most days in moist forest and riparian areas
- 61. Lincoln's Sparrow Melospiza lincolnii Good looks at this handsome sparrow on most days
- 62. White-crowned Sparrow Zonotrichia leucophrys Common bird of grassland areas
- 63. Dark-eyed Junco Junco hyemalis Seen most days in forested areas
- 64. Western Tanager Piranga ludoviciana Great looks near NE entrance of Yellowstone Park
- 65. Red-winged Blackbird Agelaius phoeniceus Common in marsh areas
- 66. Western Meadowlark Sturnella neglecta Sang loudly in Lamar Valley while we watched a wolf
- 67. Brewer's Blackbird Euphagus cyanocephalus Around Old Faithful geyser and basin
- 68. Brown-headed Cowbird Molothrus ater Common at Yellowstone Lake, Hayden & Lamar Valleys
- 69. Gray-crowned Rosy Finch Leucosticte tephrocotis Several near Beartooth Pass on snowfields
- 70. Black Rosy-Finch Leucosticte atrata Several on Beartooth Pass summit on edge of snowfields
- 71. Cassin's Finch Carpodacus cassinii At Oxbow Bend and around Cooke City, Montana
- 72. Pine Siskin Spinus At Jackson Lake Lodge, Trout Lake and on Beartooth Highway
- 73. American Dipper Cinclus mexicanus At Lewis River and LeHardy Rapids
- 74. House Sparrow Passer domesticus In Cody, Wyoming and Billings, Montana

FROGS AND TOADS

Boreal Chorus Frog *pseudacris maculate* – Near Yellowstone Lake

MAMMALS

Mule Deer Odocoileus hemionus - Seen almost daily

American Muskrat Ondatra zibethicus – At Trout Lake

Red Squirrel Sciurus vulgaris – Seen most days in both national parks

Uinta Ground Squirrel *Urocitellus armatus* – On Beartooth Highway

Richardson's Ground Squirrel *Urocitellus richardsonii* – Common in low-elevation, arid regions

Golden-mantled Ground Squirrel Callospermophilus lateralis – Dunraven and Beartooth Passes

Yellow-bellied Marmot Marmota flaviventris – Common throughout Yellowstone Park

Yellow-Pine Chipmunk Neotamias amoenus – A few seen in both National Parks

Least Chipmunk Tamias minimus – Abundant in both National Parks

Gray Wolf Canis lupus – One seen clearly and at length: "Middle Gray" female in Lamar Valley

Red Fox Vulpes vulpes – Two seen on road in Silver Gate, Montana

Black Bear Ursus americanus – Two grazing on steep grassy slopes at NE entrance of Yellowstone

Grizzly Bear *Ursus arctos horribilis* – Two separate sightings: one at Fishing Bridge; one near NE entrance to Yellowstone Park. Three total Grizzlies seen.

Pronghorn Antilocapra americana – Seen almost daily; many with fawns

Bison Bison bison – Thousands seen in Yellowstone Park, and some in Montana near Park

Mountain Goat Oreamnos americanus – 12 near Barronette Peak in NE Yellowstone; some with kids

Moose Alces alces – One seen in distance at Willow Flats; one cow seen well east of Cooke City,

Montana – both had calves

American Elk *Cervus elaphus* – Hundreds in Hayden Valley; beautiful display by two bucks in Yellowstone Lake; more east of Lakes Lodge
