## **BIRDS**

**Canada Goose** *Branta canadensis* – Seen on several days, especially near Gustavus dock. **Harlequin Duck** *Histrionicus histrionicus* – Two seen in upper Glacier Bay.

Surf Scoter Melanitta perspicillata – Sizeable flocks in Glacier Bay.

- **Pelagic Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax pelagicus* Seen in Glacier Bay and Icy Strait, including large colony on South Marble Island.
- **Great Blue Heron** *Ardea herodias* Six at Bartlett Cove dock, six at Pleasant Island, a few at Gustavus dock.

Osprey Pandion haliaetus - Seen on first two days in and around Gustavus

Northern Harrier *Circus cyaneus* – One seen in beach near Alaska Ferry dock at Gustavus Sharp-shinned Hawk *Accipiter striatus* – One above bog on first Bartlett Cove walk; another on Nagoonberry trail hike.

**Bald Eagle** *Haliaeetus leucocephalus* – Seen every day, usually in double-digit numbers. **Red-tailed Hawk** *B. jamaicensis*— One seen in open field north of Gustavus Inn.

Black Oystercatcher Haematopus bachmani – Seen in groups along the shore of Glacier Bay.

Killdeer Charadrius vociferous - Three seen at Gustavus Airport - even on the runway!

- **Spotted Sandpiper** *Actitis macularius* Reliably seen from Salmon River bridge near Inn on gravel bars in the river.
- Greater Yellowlegs Tringa melanoleuca Common on shores of Salmon River near Inn

**Lesser Yellowlegs** *Tringa flavipe* – Spotted by Debra and Ralph on Salmon River **Whimbrel** *Numenius phaeopus* – Seen twice on consecutive days at beach near Gustavus dock.

Least Sandpiper Calidris minutilla – Also found at beach by Gustavus dock

- **Wilson's Snipe** *Gallinago delicate* One spotted by Lori in grasslands between Inn and Gustavus dock.
- **Red-necked Phalarope** *Phalaropus fulicarius* Several flocks seen on Glacier Bay and Whalewatching boat trips.
- **Pomarine Jaeger** *Stercorarius pomarinus* One spotted by Lori flying among Kittiwakes above beach on Chichagof Island at Point Adolphus
- **Parasitic Jaeger** *Stercorarius parasiticus* Seen both days on Glacier Bay boat tours harassing Kittiwakes for food near water surface.

Common Murre Uria aalge – Seen most days, including large numbers on South Marble Island

Pigeon Guillemot Cepphus Columba – Seen most days in Glacier Bay, Icy Strait, and Gustavus Dock
Marbled Murrelet Brachyramphus marmoratus – Seen frequently in Glacier Bay and Icy Strait
Kittlitz's Murrelet Brachyramphus brevirostris – Two spotted briefly by Debra and Ralph in upper Glacier Bay
Horned Puffin Fratercula corniculata – Four in Glacier Bay
Tufted Puffin Fratercula cirrhata – Dozens in Glacier Bay
Black-legged Kittiwake Rissa tridactyla – Numerous in Glacier Bay, Icy Straits and Gustavus dock.

Bonaparte's Gull Chroicocephalus Philadelphia Small groups

seen on days in Glacier Bay and Icy Straits

- **Mew Gull** *Larus canus* A few individuals seen in tide flats near Bartlett Cove and Gustavus docks
- **Glaucous-winged Gull** *Larus glaucescens* One of most common gulls of the trip in salt water environs.

Caspian Tern Hydroprogne caspia – Seen on two days near Gustavus ferry dock

**Eurasian Collared-Dove** *Streptopelia decaocto*—One spotted by Debra and Ralph near Salmon River Bridge.

**Vaux's Swift** *Chaetura vauxi* - Small airborne groups seen flitting around fields north of inn. **Anna's Hummingbird** *Calypte anna* – One on feeder between inn and garden.

**Rufous Hummingbird** *Selasphorus rufus* – Seen every day feeding mostly in flowers at Inn **Belted Kingfisher** *Megaceryle alcyon* – Six at Bartlett Cove dock; two at Gustavus ferry dock.

Northern Flicker Colaptes auratus – One heard in Gustavus on north side of Salmon River.

- **Red-breasted Sapsucker** *Sphyrapicus ruber* One seen by Debra and Lori near Bartlett Cove dock after first foray into Glacier Bay.
- Northern Three-toed Woodpecker Picoides dorsalis Heard at Bartlett Cove

Peregrine Falcon Falco peregrinus – Spotted by Lori in trees near Gustavus dock.

- Pacific Slope Flycatcher Empidonax difficilis Spotted by Bonnie on Nagoonberry Loop trail.
- Northwestern Crow *Corvus caurinus* Several large flocks at Bartlett Cove as we departed on ferry; more seen near Gustavus ferry dock.

Common Raven C. corax—Seen and heard most days of the trip in forested environs.

**Violet-green Swallow** *Tachycineta thalassina* – Seen in moist fields north of Inn and along Salmon River.

**Barn Swallow** *Hirundo rustica*—Most common swallow of trip; many seen at Bartlett Cove dock, including some that perched on our tour boat.

- Chestnut-backed Chickadee Poecile rufescens Seen and heard most days of the trip in the temperate rainforest.
- Red-breasted Nuthatch Sitta Canadensis Heard often on rainforest hikes.

Golden-crowned Kinglet Regulus satrapa – Seen and heard frequently in Gustavus and on rainforest walks.

Ruby-crowned Kinglet Regulus calendula – Several seen near Bartlett Cove dock.

American Robin *Turdus migratorius*— Many seen daily at Gustavus Inn.

Varied Thrush Ixoreus naevius – Heard near Gustavus Inn.

Orange-crowned Warbler Oreothlypis celata – Several seen on grounds around Inn.

Yellow-rumped Warbler Setophaga coronate – Several near Inn and Salmon Creek.

Townsend's Warbler Setophaga townsendi – A few in temperate rainforest at Bartlett Cove

Wilson's Warbler Wilsonia pusilla— A few seen in Spruce trees and shrubs around Inn.

Fox Sparrow Passerella iliaca – In grasslands on the road to Gustavus dock.

Dark-eyed Junco Junco hyemalis – A daily sighting on grounds and in garden at Inn.

White-crowned Sparrow Zonotrichia leucophrys— One seen and photographed by Ralph near Gustavus dock.

Savannah Sparrow Passerculus sandwichensis – Several seen in fields near Gustavus dock. Song Sparrow Melospiza melodia – Seen near Gustavus Dock.

Lincoln's Sparrow *Melospiza lincolnii* – One on first day in fields between Inn and dock.

**Red Crossbill** Loxia curvirostra – Moving through cone crops in conifers near Inn

Pine Siskin Spinus pinus – Heard often in forested areas; seen in Sitka Pines across from the Inn.

## MAMMALS

- Gray Wolf Canus Lupus Seen on two consecutive days foraging on the beach of Pleasant Island.
- **Brown Bear** Ursus arctos One foraging in alluvial fan near Reid Glacier, upper Glacier Bay.
- Harbor Seal Phoca vitulina Seen in several bays and estuaries
- Steller's Sea Lion *Eumetopia jubatus* A great many seen hauled out at South Marble Island in Glacier Bay; others seen in Icy Strait and at Gustavus dock.





North American River Otter Lontra Canadensis – A group of 7 near Bartlett Cove dock Sea Otter Enhydra lutris -Saw many, including the one on left eating a Basket Starfish in Icy Strait Black-tailed Sitka Deer-Several on shoreline of Chichigof Island

Mountain Goat Oreamnos americanus – Five seen on Gloomy Knob, Glacier Bay

Minke Whale Balaenoptera acutorostrata - One seen by our kayakers near Pleasant Island

Humpback Whale *Megaptera novaeangliae* – Double-digit Humpbacks seen in Glacier Bay and especially, off Point Adolphus – a spectacular show!

- **Killer Whale** *Orcinus orca* Several individuals seen in upper Glacier Bay
- Harbor Porpoise *Phocoena phocoena* Seen most often in Icy Strait
- **Red Squirrel** *Tamiasciurus hudsonicus* Scolded us on Nagoonberry Trail
- **Porcupine** *Erethizon dorsatum* Large one seen on roadside on the way to Bartlett Cove.
