Sites visited (see detailed day-by-day itinerary at end of document): Houghton area, Keweenaw Peninsula, Copper Harbor, Isle Royale

Summary: 52 species of birds, 8 species of mammals, 2 species herps, and 3 species of insects

## BIRDS (52 species recorded):

# **DUCKS, GEESE AND SWANS: Anatidae (8)**

**Canada Goose** *Branta canadensis*—Found on the first 3 days of the trip on the Keweenaw Peninsula, at Copper Harbor, and on Isle Royale

Wood Duck Aix sponsa—Seen on the first 2 days of the trip on the Keweenaw Peninsula

**Gadwall** Mareca strepera—(LO) Seen by Ed on one day on the Keweenaw

Mallard Anas platyrhynchos—Found on all the days at Isle Royale

Ring-necked Duck Aythya collaris—Seen on one day in Tobin Harbor, Isle Royale

**Greater Scaup** Aythya marila— Seen on one day in Tobin Harbor, Isle Royale

**Common Goldeneye** Bucephala clangula— Seen on one day in Tobin Harbor, Isle Royale

**Common Merganser** *Mergus merganser*—one of the most commonly encountered species, found on all 7 days of the tour, frequently in variable size flocks and often performing synchronized diving demonstrations.

## **PIGEONS AND DOVES: Columbidae (1)**

Rock Pigeon Columba livia (I)—Seen on the first day of the tour in Houghton

#### **CRANES:** Gruidae (1)

Sandhill Crane Antigone canadensis—Heard on two days on Isle Royale

## **SANDPIPERS AND ALLIES: Scolopacidae (1)**

**Spotted Sandpiper** *Actitis macularius*—Seen on 3 of the days on Isle Royale, sometimes on the rocky shores

## **GULLS AND TERNS: Laridae (2)**

**Ring-billed Gull** Larus delawarensis—Seen on 5 days of the tour and found almost anywhere near Lake Superior

Herring Gull Larus argentatus—Found on 5 days when on the Lake Superior coastline

# LOONS: Gaviidae (1)

**Common Loon** *Gavia immer*—Seen and often heard, either while in the water or while flying, on all the days on Isle Royale

# **CORMORANTS: Phalacrocoracidae (1)**

**Double-crested Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax auritus*—Seen going and coming into Copper Harbor while on the Isle Royale Queen and again at the Rock Harbor lighthouse.

# **HERONS AND EGRETS: Ardeidae (1)**

Great Blue Heron Ardea herodias—One found on Lake Fanny Hooe

## **NEW WORLD VULTURES: Cathartidae (1)**

Turkey Vulture Cathartes aura—Seen only once at Boston Pond Nature Area

# **OSPREY: Pandionidae (1)**

Osprey Pandion haliaetus—Seen on one day on Isle Royale

## **HAWKS, KITES AND EAGLES: Accipitridae (2)**

**Bald Eagle** *Haliaeetus leucocephalus*—Seen on 4 days either on Isle Royale or near Lake Superior **Broad-winged Hawk** *Buteo platypterus*—Seen one day on Isle Royale

# KINGFISHERS: Alcedinidae (1)

Belted Kingfisher Megaceryle alcyon—Seen on 4 days in a variety of places with wetlands

## **WOODPECKERS: Picidae (2)**

**Hairy Woodpecker** *Dryobates villosus*—Seen on 6 days of the tour, including almost all of the days on Isle Royale

**Pileated Woodpecker** *Dryocopus pileatus*—Seen on 5 days of the tour, including almost all of the days on Isle Royale

#### FALCONS AND CARACARAS: Falconidae (2)

**American Kestrel** *Falco sparverius*—Seen on 2 days while at Isle Royale, including at the lighthouse **Peregrine Falco** *peregrinus*—Seen once while at Rock Harbor lighthouse

## **TYRANT FLYCATCHERS: Tyrannidae (1)**

**Eastern Kingbird** *Tyrannus tyrannus*—Only found on the first day of the tour, several perched in a tree in the wetlands at Paavola Wetlands Nature Area

## **VIREOS: Vireonidae (1)**

**Red-eyed Vireo** *Vireo olivaceus*—Seen at Hunter's Point in Copper Harbor and on the first full day on Isle Royale; otherwise oddly absent

#### CROWS AND JAYS: Corvidae (4)

**Canada Jay** *Perisoreus canadensis*—Seen on 5 of 6 days on Isle Royale, often when 2 birds would swing by the Rock Harbor lodge dining room

Blue Jay Cyanocitta cristata—Found on 4 days, both on the Keweenaw and on Isle Royale

American Crow Corvus brachyrhynchos—Only found 1 day at Hunter's Point

**Common Raven** *Corvus corax*—Seen on 5 days at several sites, including on the Keweenaw and on Isle Royale

## **TITS AND CHICKADEES: Paridae (1)**

**Black-capped Chickadee** *Poecile atricapillus*—A species regularly found at several sites on the Keweenaw and Isle Royale

## **KINGLETS: Regulidae (2)**

**Golden-crowned Kinglet** *Regulus satrapa*—Found on 4 of the days on Isle Royale **Ruby-crowned Kinglet** *Regulus calendula*—(LO) Found by Dave on the morning of our last day on Isle Royale

#### **NUTHATCHES: Sittidae (1)**

Red-breasted Nuthatch Sitta canadensis—Found on 4 days on Isle Royale

# **THRUSHES: Turdidae (1)**

American Robin Turdus migratorius—Found on 2 days on Isle Royale

## **FINCHES: Fringillidae (1)**

Purple Finch Haemorhous purpureus—Found one day along the Rock Harbor trail, Isle Royale

#### **NEW WORLD SPARROWS: Passerellidae (3)**

White-throated Sparrow Zonotrichia albicollis—Reported on 2 days on Isle Royale Song Sparrow Melospiza melodia—Reported on 1 of the days on Isle Royale Lincoln's Sparrow Melospiza lincolnii—Reported on 1 of the days on Isle Royale

## **NEW WORLD BLACKBIRDS: Icteridae (1)**

**Brown-headed Cowbird** *Molothrus ater*—A single bird found one day on Isle Royale; apparently a juvenile

## **NEW WORLD WARBLERS: Parulidae (10)**

**Tennessee Warbler** Oreothlypis peregrina—Seen on one day on Isle Royale along the Tobin Harbor trail

Nashville Warbler Oreothlypis ruficapilla—(GO) Seen on one day in Rock Harbor by Dave

American Redstart Setophaga ruticilla—Found on 3 days on Isle Royale

Cape May Warbler Setophaga tigrina—Seen on 2 days on Isle Royale

Magnolia Warbler Setophaga magnolia—Seen on 1 day on Isle Royale

Bay-breasted Warbler Setophaga castanea—Seen on 2 days on Isle Royale

Blackburnian Warbler Setophaga fusca—Seen on 1 day on Isle Royale

**Palm Warbler** Setophaga palmarum—Seen on 2 days on Isle Royale

**Yellow-rumped Warbler** *Setophaga coronata*— Most frequently encountered warbler species of the tour, seen on 5 days on Isle Royale, all of the Myrtle (eastern) race

Black-throated Green Warbler Setophaga virens—Seen on 1 day on Isle Royale

## CARDINALS, GROSBEAKS, AND ALLIES: Cardinalidae (1)

Northern Cardinal Cardinalis cardinalis—(LO) One heard by Ed on Isle Royale

# Mammals (8 species)

**American Red Squirrel** *Tamiasciurus hudsonicus*—Found regularly on Isle Royale, where the endemic subspecies is very tame

Eastern Chipmunk Tamias striatus—Found on one day at Hunter's Point Park

American Beaver Castor canadensis—Seen on 2 days on Isle Royale

**Snowshoe Hare** *Lepus americanus*—Seen on 3 days on Isle Royale

**Gray Wolf** *Canis lupus*—Apparent footprints seen (and photographed!) on the boardwalk in the bog on Raspberry Island

Moose Alces alces—Only seen (alive!) once by a few on one of our days on Isle Royale

**North American River Otter** *Lontra canadensis*—Seen 1 day on Isle Royale at the seaplane dock in Tobin Harbor

White-footed Mouse Peromyscus leucopus—Seen running around the picnic tables on one day on Isle Royale

## Herps (2 species)

**Common Garter Snake** *Thamnophis sirtalis*—Found on 1 day on Isle Royale **American Toad** *Anaxyrus americanus*—Found on 1 day on Isle Royale

## Insects (3 species)

Monarch Danaus plexippus—Seen on 3 days on Isle Royale

**Isabella Tiger Moth** [Woolly Bear caterpillar] *Pyrrharctia isabella*—Seen on 3 days on Isle Royale, presumably portending some kind of winter coming!

Mourning Cloak Nymphalis antiopa—Seen on 2 days on Isle Royale

**Compton Tortoiseshell** *Nymphalis l-album*— Seen on 1 day on Isle Royale

#### **LOCATIONS AND NOTES:**

Day 1: August 27, 2021; Paavola Wetlands Nature Area, Boston Pond Nature Area, Calumet, Eagle River, The Jampot, Eagle Harbor, Lake Fanny Hooe (lake and resort), Copper Harbor

Day 2: August 28, 2021; Hunter's Point Park (Copper Harbor), Isle Royale

Day 3: August 29, 2021; Isle Royale—Tobin Harbor trail, Suzy's Cave, Rock Harbor trail

Day 4: August 30, 2021; Isle Royale—Rock Harbor area, Rock Harbor lighthouse/Edisen Fishery/ Bangsund Cabin

Day 5: August 31, 2021; Isle Royale—Rock Harbor area, Tobin Harbor Trail, Suzy's Cave, Rock Harbor Trail, Three Mile Campground

Day 6: September 1, 2021; Isle Royale—Raspberry Island, Rock Harbor area

Day 7: September 2, 2021; Isle Royale—Rock Harbor area (Dave only)
