Brown-throated Three-toed Sloth – Heliconia Island, Saraquipi Collared Peccary – La Selva Hoffman's Two-toed Sloth – La Selva Kinkajou – Heard during owl prowl at Rancho Naturalista – a rhythmic scratching sound Mantled Howler Monkey – Rancho Naturalista, Heliconia Island, La Selva Short-tailed Fruit Bat – Rancho Naturalista – flew inches from us on owl prowl Variegated Squirrel – Savegre, Rancho Naturalista
