Tour Summary:

The Sept 2022 Kenya Wildlife Safari took us, during 14 days, to 5 major regions of southeastern Kenya: Nairobi (including Nairobi National Park), the Rift Valley (including Lakes Baringo and Bogoria), the Kakamega Forest, Lake Nakuru National Park (including Lake Naivasha), and the Masai Mara National Reserve. A total of 45 mammal species were observed, including elephant, giraffe, zebra, lion, leopard, cheetah, black and white rhinos, warthogs, gazelles, impala, and wildebeest. A total of 353 bird species were seen by at least one of the trip participants, with the vast majority being observed by more than one participant. 223 species were seen on multiple days. Very few species were seen only by one of the two guides, but with most observations being made from within 2 different Land Rovers that often were not close together, it was impossible to guarantee that every participant saw every species. In this list no birds are included which were recorded only by sound.
