Southern Costa Rica: Birding & Nature | Species List February 14 – 24, 2023 | with Naturalist Journeys

Summary: Naturalist Journeys February 2023 tour to southern Costa Rica featured wonderful scenery and of course, many wonderful birds including 23 species of hummingbirds, 27 species of flycatchers and 25 species of tanagers and their allies. In addition, several mammals, reptiles and amphibians were seen and heard. The complete list follows.

Ruddy Ground-Dove *Columbina talpacoti*— (5) Seen at multiple locations.

Blue Ground-Dove *Claravis pretiosa*— (3) Heard first then seen near La Gamba.

Ruddy Quail-Dove Geotrygon montana— (2) Seen at Esquinas Rainforest Lodge and Carara National Park.

Purple-crowned Fairy Heliothryx barroti— (1) Seen at Esquinas Rainforest Lodge. Veraguan Mango Anthracothorax veraguensis— (1) A male and female were seen near the Ciudad Neily rice fields. Talamanca Hummingbird Eugenes spectabillis— (2) RE, seen at Paraiso Quetzales and Savegre Mountain Lodge. Long-billed Starthroat Heliomaster longirostris— (1) Lone bird seen near Ciudad Neily rice fields. **Plain-capped Starthroat** *Heliomaster constantii*— (1) Lone bird seen near Garabito. Fiery-throated Hummingbird Panterpe insignis— (1) RE, seen at Paraiso Quetzales. White-throated Mountain-gem Lampornis castaneoventris— (2) RE, seen at Paraiso Quetzales and at Savegre Mountain Lodge. **Ruby-throated Hummingbird** Archilochus colubris— (1) Lone bird seen near Garabito. Volcano Hummingbird Selasphorus flammula— (3) RE, seen at Paraiso Quetzales, the Savegre Valley and at the communication towers off the Pan-American Highway. **Scintillant Hummingbird** *Selasphorus scintilla*— (2) RE, seen in the Savegre Valley. **Violet-headed Hummingbird** *Klais quimeti*— (3) Seen at Esquinas Rainforest Lodge. **Crowned Woodnymph** *Thalurania colombica*— (4) Seen on the entry road to Esquinas Rainforest Lodge. **Coppery-headed Emerald** *Elvira cupreiceps*— (1) E, lone female seen at Palo Verde del Guarco. **Stripe-tailed Hummingbird** *Eupherusa eximia*— (1) Lone bird seen at Savegre Mountain Lodge. Blue-vented Hummingbird Saucerottia hoffmanni— (2) RE, seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Palo Verde del Guarco and Hotel Cerro Lodge. Mangrove Hummingbird Amazilia boucardi— (2) Seen on the boat tour of the Rio Coto Colorado estuary and mangroves and on the Tarcoles River boat tour.

Cinnamon Hummingbird *Amazilia rutila*— (2) Seen at Hotel Cerro Lodge and near Garabito.

Rufous-tailed Hummingbird *Amazilia tzacatl*— (7) Most common and widespread hummer, seen at multiple locations.

Blue-throated Goldentail Chlorestes eliciae— (1) Lone bird seen briefly at Los Cusingos.

RAILS, COOTS AND ALLIES: Rallidae (3)

Gray-cowled Wood-Rail Aramides cajaneus— (3) Seen at Esquinas Rainforest Lodge and surrounding area. **Purple Gallinule** Porphyrio martinica—(2) Seen on entry road to Esquinas Rainforest Lodge and on Tarcoles River boat tour.

White-throated Crake Laterallus albigularis— (1) HO, on entry road to Esquinas Rainforest Lodge.

Western Sandpiper *Calidris mauri*— (1) Seen on the boat tour of the Rio Coto Colorado estuary and mangroves. **Short-billed Dowitcher** *Limnodromus griseus*— (1) Seen on the boat tour of the Rio Coto Colorado estuary and mangroves.

Willet *Tringa semipalmata*— (1) Seen on the boat tour of the Rio Coto Colorado estuary and mangroves and the Tarcoles River boat tour.

GULLS, TERNS AND SKIMMERS: Ciconiidae (5)
