# Ohio: The Biggest Week in Birding | Species List May 10 – 17, 2023 | with Naturalist Journeys

Bird enthusiasts from Connecticut, Florida, Kansas, Massachusetts and Minnesota traveled to northern Ohio to experience the spring passage of neotropical migrants and in particular, warblers, along the Magee Marsh Boardwalk. Several visits to the boardwalk did not disappoint as the group was afforded close up looks at numerous species of warblers and several other species as well. For the week we tallied 28 species of warblers (21 of which were seen from the Magee Marsh Boardwalk), 12 species of waterfowl, 11 species of shorebirds, 11 species of sparrows, several species each of waders, woodpeckers, flycatchers, vireos, swallows and thrushes and one seldom seen nightjar. The total number of species came to 151. To see a detailed list, please keep reading.

# DUCKS, GEESE AND SWANS: Anatidae (12)

**Lesser Scaup** *Aythya affinis*—(1) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark.

**Hooded Merganser** *Lophodytes cucullatus*—(1) A single bird (female/first spring male) was seen at Ottawa NWR. **Common Merganser** *Mergus merganser*—(1) Two were seen at Cuyahoga Valley National Park. **Ruddy Duck** *Oxyura jamaicensis*—(1) Seen at Howard Marsh Metropark.
