Costa Rica Fall Migration | Species List October 9 - 19, 2023 | with Naturalist Journeys

Summary: The 2023 Costa Rica's Caribbean Side with Naturalist Journeys featured lots of wonderful birds as expected, with 28 species of hummingbirds, 31 species of flycatchers, 23 species of warblers and 21 species of tanagers and their allies. Even though birds were the focus of the tour, there were always interesting mammals or reptiles or amphibians to see at each stop. To see the complete list of what was seen and where, please keep reading.

BIRDS (294 species recorded, of which 16 were heard only):

- (HO)= Distinctive enough to be counted as heard only, pointed out to the group
- (#) after family is number of species in the family
- (#) after species is the number of days of 10 the bird was seen or heard
- (E) = Endemic to Costa Rica
- (RE) = Endemic to the region, typically Costa Rica and Panama, sometimes shared with Nicaragua

TINAMOUS: Tinamidae (2)

Great Tinamou *Tinamus major*— (4) Heard and seen at Maquenque Eco Lodge and a family of three (1 adult and 2 young) were seen from one of the trails at La Selva Biological Station. **Slaty-breasted Tinamou** *Crypturellus boucardi*— (2) HO, at Maquenque.

DUCKS, GEESE AND SWANS: Anatidae (2)

Black-bellied Whistling-Duck *Dendrocygna autumnalis*— (5) Approximately 100 were at Maquenque and 5 were seen at Angostura Lagoon.

Blue-winged Teal Spatula discors— (3) Seen at Maguenque and Angostura Lagoon.

GUANS AND CURASSOWS: Cracidae (3)

Gray-headed Chachalaca *Ortalis cinereiceps*— (5) Seen at Maquenque and Rancho Naturalista. **Crested Guan** *Penelope purpurescens*—(2) Seen at Maquenque and heard at Casa Calateas. **Great Curassow** *Crax rubra*— (3) Seen at Maquenque.

PIGEONS AND DOVES: Columbidae (9)

Rock Pigeon (I) *Columba livia*— (5) Seen at multiple locations and primarily in larger communities. **Pale-vented Pigeon** *Patagioenas cayennensis*— (4) Seen at Maquenque, Cope's and Cariblue Beach Resort.

Red-billed Pigeon *Patagioenas flavirostris*— (4) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea and Rancho Naturalista.

Short-billed Pigeon *Patagioenas nigrirostris*— (6) Primarily only heard at several locations, but 4 were seen perched in a tree at La Selva Biological Station.

Inca Dove *Columbina inca*— (2) HO, at Hotel Bougainvillea.

Ruddy Ground-Dove *Columbina talpacoti*— (4) Seen at Maquenque, near La Selva Biological Station and at Angostura Lagoon.

Blue Ground-Dove *Claravis pretiosa*— (1) HO, at Maquenque.

White-tipped Dove Leptotila verreauxi— (4) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, La Selva Biological Station and Rancho Naturalista.

White-winged Dove Zenaida asiatica— (3) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea and Rancho Naturalista.

CUCKOOS AND ALLIES: Cuculidae (2)

Groove-billed Ani *Crotophaga sulcirostris*— (5) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Maquenque, on the San Carlos River boat tour and near La Selva Biological Station.

Squirrel Cuckoo *Piaya cayana*— (4) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea, Maquenque, on the San Carlos River boat tour and at Rancho Naturalista.

NIGHTJARS: Caprimulgidae (1)

Common Pauraque *Nyctidromus albicollis*— (1) Four seen on a night walk at Maquenque (heard daily there as well) and heard at Selva Verde Lodge.

POTOOS: Nyctibiidae — (1)

Great Potoo Nyctibius grandis — (1) One seen near Cope's.

SWIFTS: Apodidae (2)

White-collared Swift Streptoprocne zonaris— (3) Seen over the town of Poasito, on the San Carlos River boat tour and at Rancho Naturalista.

Gray-rumped Swift Chaetura cinereiventris— (2) Seen at La Selva Biological Station.

HUMMINGBIRDS: Trochilidae (28)

White-necked Jacobin Florisuga mellivora— (3) Seen at Cope's and was a regular at the feeders at Rancho Naturalista.

Bronzy Hermit *Glaucis aeneus*— (1) Seen at Maquenque.

Green Hermit Phaethornis guy— (3) Seen at Colibri Cafe and Rancho Naturalista.

Long-billed Hermit *Phaethornis longirostris*— (6) Seen at Maquenque, Frogs Heaven, Selva Verde Lodge, Cope's and Casa Calateas.

Stripe-throated Hermit *Phaethornis striigularis*— (5) Seen at Virgen del Socorro, Maquenque, Selva Verde Lodge and Rancho Naturalista.

Brown Violetear *Colibri delphinae*— (1) Seen at Colibri Cafe.

Purple-crowned Fairy *Heliothryx barroti*— (2) Seen at the hummingbird bathing pools at Rancho Naturalista.

Green-breasted Mango *Anthracothorax prevostii*— (3) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea and Rancho Naturalista.

Green Thorntail *Discosura conversii*— (1) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Black-crested Coquette Lophornis helenae— (1) An adult male was seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Green-crowned Brilliant *Heliodoxa jacula*— (2) Seen at Colibri Cafe and Rancho Naturalista.

Long-billed Starthroat *Heliomaster longirostris*— (2) Seen at Maguenque.

Fiery-throated Hummingbird (RE) *Panterpe insignis*— (1) Seen along the entrance road to Poas Volcano National Park.

Purple-throated Mountain-gem (RE) *Lampornis calolaemus*— (1) Male and female seen at hummingbird feeders in Poasito.

Ruby-throated Hummingbird *Archilochus colubris*— (1) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea.

Scintillant Hummingbird (RE) *Selasphorus scintilla*— (1) Seen along the entrance road to Poas Volcano National Park.

Garden Emerald Chlorostilbon assimilis— (1) Seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Violet-headed Hummingbird *Klais guimeti*— (2) Seen at Selva Verde Lodge and Rancho Naturalista.

Violet Sabrewing Campylopterus hemileucurus— (2) Seen at Colibri Cafe and Rancho Naturalista.

Bronze-tailed Plumeleteer *Chalybura urochrysia*— (3) Seen at La Selva Biological Station and Cope's and Selva Verde Lodge.

Crowned Woodnymph *Thalurania colombica*— (4) Seen at La Selva Biological Station, Casa Calateas and Rancho Naturalista.

Snowcap (RE) Microchera albocoronata— (2) Both male and female were seen at Rancho Naturalista.

Coppery-headed Emerald (E) *Microchera cupreiceps*— (1) A male was seen at Colibri Cafe.

Black-bellied Hummingbird (RE) Eupherusa nigriventris— (1) A male was seen at Colibri Cafe.

Scaly-breasted Hummingbird *Phaeochroa cuvierii*— (3) Seen at Maquenque, Selva Verde Lodge and Cope's.

Blue-vented Hummingbird *Saucerottia hoffmanni*— (2) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea.

Rufous-tailed Hummingbird *Amazilia tzacatl*— (9) Most common hummingbird species encountered on the trip. Seen at multiple locations.

Blue-chested Hummingbird *Polyerata amabilis*— (2) Seen at Maquenque and Casa Calateas.

RAILS, COOTS AND ALLIES: Rallidae (4)

Russet-naped Wood-Rail Aramides albiventris—(3) Seen at Maguenque and Cope's.

Gray-cowled Wood-Rail Aramides cajaneus— (1) Seen at Cariblue Beach Resort.

Purple Gallinule *Porphyrio martinica*—(4) Adults and juveniles seen at Maquenque.

White-throated Crake Laterallus albigularis— (3) HO, at Maquenque.

LIMPKIN: Aramidae (1)

Limpkin Aramus guarauna— (1) Seen at Angostura Lagoon.

PLOVERS AND LAPWINGS: Charadriidae (2)

Southern Lapwing Vanellus chilensis— (2) Seen at Maquenque and Angostura Lagoon.

Semipalmated Plover *Charadrius semipalmatus*— (1) Seen at Cahuita National Park.

JACANAS: Jacanidae (1)

Northern Jacana *Jacana spinosa*— (4) Seen at Maquenque.

SANDPIPERS AND ALLIES: Scolopacidae (2)

Whimbrel Numenius phaeopus— (3) Seen on the beach at Cariblue Beach Resort.

Spotted Sandpiper *Actitis macularius*— (4) Seen on the San Carlos and Sarapiqui Rivers and along the Caribbean coast.

SUNBITTERN: Eurypygidae (1)

Sunbittern *Eurypyga helias*— (2) Seen twice on the Tuis River near Rancho Naturalista.

STORKS: Ciconiidae (1)

Wood Stork *Mycteria americana*— (1) Three birds were seen together in flight on the San Carlos River boat tour.

FRIGATEBIRDS: Fregatidae (1)

Magnificent Frigatebird Fregata magnificens— (1) Seen at Cahuita National Park.

ANHINGAS: Anhingidae (1)

Anhinga Anhinga anhinga— (3) Seen at Maquenque and on the Sarapiqui River boat tour.

CORMORANTS: Phalacrocoracidae (1)

Neotropic Cormorant *Nannopterum brasilianum*— (1) Seen on the Sarapiqui River at Selva Verde Lodge.

HERONS AND EGRETS: Ardeidae (9)

Bare-throated Tiger-Heron *Tigrisoma mexicanum*— (5) Seen at Maquenque and along the Sarapiqui River at Selva Verde Lodge.

Great Blue Heron *Ardea herodias*— (3) Seen at Maquenque, Cahuita National Park and Angostura Lagoon.

Great Egret *Ardea alba*— (6) Seen at Maquenque, on the San Carlos River boat tour, Cariblue Beach Resort and Angostura Lagoon.

Snowy Egret *Egretta thula*— (1) Seen on the Sarapiqui River boat tour.

Little Blue Heron *Egretta caerulea*— (3) Seen at Maquenque, on the San Carlos River boat tour and Angostura Lagoon.

Cattle Egret *Bubulcus ibis*— (6) Seen in multiple locations with livestock when en route, on the San Carlos River boat tour and at Rancho Naturalista.

Green Heron *Butorides virescens*— (6) Seen at Maquenque, on the Sarapiqui River boat tour and at Angostura Lagoon.

Yellow-crowned Night-Heron *Nyctanassa violacea*— (2) Seen on the San Carlos River boat tour and at Angostura Lagoon.

Boat-billed Heron *Cochlearius* — (2) Seen at Maquenque and on the San Carlos River boat tour.

IBIS AND SPOONBILLS: Threskiornithidae (1)

Green Ibis *Mesembrinibis cayennensis*—(3) Seen at Maquenque, on the San Carlos River boat tour and heard at La Selva Biological Station.

NEW WORLD VULTURES: Cathartidae (3)

King Vulture *Sarcoramphus papa*— (3) Seen at Maquenque and on the San Carlos River boat tour. **Black Vulture** *Coragyps atratus*— (10) Numerous, seen daily.

Turkey Vulture *Cathartes aura*— (8) Numerous, seen nearly daily, with the largest concentrations near Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui.

OSPREY: Pandionidae (1)

Osprey *Pandion haliaetus*— (4) Seen on the San Carlos River boat tour, Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui, Casa Calateas and Cahuita National Park.

HAWKS, KITES AND EAGLES: Accipitridae (12)

White-tailed Kite Elanus leucurus— (1) Seen at Angostura Lagoon.

Gray-headed Kite *Leptodon cayanensis*— (1) An adult and a juvenile were seen flying together on the San Carlos River boat tour.

Snail Kite Rostrhamus sociabilis— (1) Seen at Angostura Lagoon.

Double-toothed Kite *Harpagus bidentatus*— (1) Seen at La Selva Biological Station.

Mississippi Kite *Ictinia mississippiensis*— (1) Approximately 40 were seen in a kettle at Maquenque and 3 more were seen from the hawkwatch platform at Casa Calateas.

Common Black Hawk *Buteogallus anthracinus*— (1) Seen at Cariblue Beach Resort.

Roadside Hawk *Rupornis magnirostris*— (4) Seen at Maquenque, Puerto Viejo de Sarapiqui, Cope's, Cariblue Beach Resort, Rancho Naturalista and Angostura Lagoon.

Semiplumbeous Hawk *Leucopternis semiplumbeus*— (1) HO, at La Selva Biological Station.

Gray Hawk Buteo plagiatus— (2) Seen en route to Maguenque and on the San Carlos River boat tour.

Broad-winged Hawk *Buteo platypterus*— (6) Seen at multiple locations with the largest numbers seen from the hawkwatch platform at Casa Calateas.

Short-tailed Hawk Buteo brachyurus— (1) A dark morph bird was seen flying above Poasito.

Swainson's Hawk *Buteo swainsoni*— (1) Approximately 150 were seen from the hawkwatch platform at Casa Calateas.

OWLS: Strigidae (2)

Crested Owl *Lophostrix cristata*— (1) Seen near Cope's.

Mottled Owl Strix virgata— (2) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea.

TROGONS: Trogonidae (3)

Slaty-tailed Trogon Trogon massena— (2) HO, near Cope's and at Casa Calateas.

Gartered Trogon *Trogon caligatus*— (3) Seen at Maquenque, heard at La Selva Biological Station and seen again at Rancho Naturalista.

Black-throated Trogon *Trogon rufus*— (1) HO, at Casa Calateas.

MOTMOTS: Momotidae (3)

Lesson's Motmot *Momotus lessonii*— (3) Seen at Hotel Bougainvillea and Rancho Naturalista.

Rufous Motmot Baryphthengus martii— (1) Seen and heard at Selva Verde Lodge.

Broad-billed Motmot *Electron platyrhynchum*— (3) Seen at Maquenque, La Selva Biological Station and Casa Calateas.

KINGFISHERS: Alcedinidae (4)

Ringed Kingfisher *Megaceryle torquata*— (2) Seen at Maquenque.

Amazon Kingfisher *Chloroceryle amazona*— (3) Seen at Maquenque and along the Tuis River near Rancho Naturalista.

American Pygmy Kingfisher Chloroceryle aenea— (1) Seen at Maquenque and Frogs Heaven.
